Cluster Stitch Shawl $118 \mathrm{~cm}, 461 / 2 i n$, long $x 95 \mathrm{~cm}, 371 / 2 \mathrm{in}$, wide at widest point

## SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

CI: make a cluster as foll: (yrh, insert hook in st, yrh and draw a loop through, yrh and draw through first 2 loops on hook) 3 times (4 loops on hook), yrh and draw through all loops on hook.

The yarn amounts stated are based on average requirements and are therefore approximate.
TENSION 14 sts and 11 rows to $10 \mathrm{~cm}, 4$ in, over cluster stitch pattern on 4 mm hook or the size required to give the correct tension.

It is essential to work to the stated tension to ensure the correct size and you should always work a tension square.
If there are less sts and rows to $10 \mathrm{~cm}, 4 \mathrm{in}$, change to a finer hook, if there are more sts and rows to $10 \mathrm{~cm}, 4 \mathrm{in}$, change to a larger hook.

## CLUSTER STITCH SHAWL

Using 4mm hook, make 3ch.
Row 1(RS): 1 htr in 3rd ch from hook, turn. 2htr.
Row 2: 2ch (counts as 1htr throughout), 2 htr in next st, turn. 3htr.
Row 3: 2ch, 1 htr in next st, 2htr in next st, turn. 4htr.
Row 4: 2ch, 1 htr in same st at base of ch, 1 htr in each st to end, turn.
5htr.
Row 5: 2ch, 1 htr in each st to last st, 2htr in last st. 6htr.
Row 6: 2ch, 1 htr in same st at base of ch, 1 htr in each st to end, turn. 7htr.
Row 7 (RS): 4ch (counts as 1 tr and 1ch), miss next st, Cl in next st, 1ch, miss next st, 1tr in next st, 1ch, miss next st, (Cl, 1ch, 1tr) in last st, turn. $3 \mathrm{tr}, 2 \mathrm{Cl}$ and $4 \times 1 \mathrm{ch} \mathrm{sps}$.
Row 8: 3ch (counts as 1ch and
1 htr and makes a step), 1 htr in 3rd ch from hook, 1 htr in st at base of $\mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{htr}$ in each st and sp to end, turn. 11htr.
Row 9: 2ch, 1 htr in each st to end, turn. 11htr.
Row 10: 3ch (counts as 1ch and 1 htr and makes a step), 1 htr in 3 rd ch from hook, 1 htr in st at base of $\mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{htr}$ in each st and sp to end, turn. 13htr.
Row 11: 4ch (counts as 1 tr and 1ch), *miss next st, Cl in next st, 1ch, miss next st, 1 tr in next st, 1ch; rep from * to end, ending with 1 tr in last st (omitting last 1ch), turn. 4tr, 3 Cl and $6 \times 1 \mathrm{ch}$ sps.
Rep rows 8-11, 29 times more. 33tr, 32Cl and $64 \times 1 \mathrm{ch}$ sps.
Rep rows $8-10$ once more. 133htr. Cut yarn and fasten off.

## TO MAKE UP

Sew in all yarn ends neatly. Pin out shawl to the measurements given, pinning out the steps on the long edge of shawl to define them.
Cover with clean, damp tea towels and leave to dry. See ball band for washing and further care instructions.
