

## **Sweater in Head Over Heels Boho**

### **MEASUREMENTS**

### **YOU WILL NEED**

Head Over Heels Boho	100g balls	1	1	2	

Colour used Arno 3127, Neva 3125

Alternative yarn Head over Heels. If using an alternative yarn, please check the meterage as the number of balls needed may vary.

1 pair 3.5 mm needles (US 4)

3 buttons diameter 2 cm, 1 in; cable needle, stitch holder

### **SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS**

C4B cable 4 back: sl next 2 sts to cable needle and hold at the back, k2, k2 from cable needle

C4F cable 4 front: sl next 2 sts to cable needle and hold at the front, k2, k2 from cable needle

st-st stocking stitch: Row 1 (rs): K to end. Row 2: P to end. Rep these 2 rows.

The yarn amounts stated are based on average requirements and are therefore approximate.

TENSION 28 sts and 36 rows to 10 cm, 4 in, over st-st on 3.5 mm needles or the size required to give the correct tension.

It is essential to work to the stated tension to ensure the correct size of garment and you should always knit a tension square.

If there are less sts and rows to 10cm, 4in, change to finer needles; if there are more sts and rows to 10cm, 4in, change to larger needles.

Instructions are given for the first, smallest size. Larger sizes are given in square brackets. Where only one figure is given, this applies to all sizes. Where the figure 0 appears, no stitches, times, or rows are worked for this

After casting off, one stitch will remain on the right-hand needle which is not included in the instructions that follow.

### Circle the size you wish to make

### BACK

Using 3.5mm needles cast on 65[75:85] sts. **Row 1 (rs):** K1, \*p1, k1; rep from \* to end.

**Row 2:** P1, \*k1, p1; rep from \* to end.

Rep last 2 rows 5 more times, dec 1 st at end of last row. 64[74:84] sts.

Work in st-st until back measures 11[14:20] cm, 4¼[5½:8] in, ending after a purl row.

### Shape Raglan

Cast off 4 sts at beg of next 2 rows. 56[66:76]

Next row: K3, sl1, k1, psso, k to last 5 sts, k2tog, k3. 2 sts dec'd

Next row: P3, p2tog, p to last 5 sts, p2tog tbl, p3. 2 sts dec'd

## For 2nd and 3rd sizes only

Rep last 2 rows twice more. [54:64] sts.

# For all sizes

Next row: K3, sl1, k1, psso, k to last 5 sts, k2tog, k3. 2 sts dec'd.

## Next row: Purl.

Rep last 2 rows 11[10:13] more times. 28[32:36] sts.

Cast off.

### **FRONT**

Using 3.5mm needles cast on 65[75:85] sts.

**Row 1 (rs):** K1, \*p1, k1; rep from \* to end. **Row 2:** P1, \*k1, p1; rep from \* to end.

Rep last 2 rows 5 more times, inc 1 st at centre of last row. 66[76:86] sts.

## Commence cable patt:

Rows 1 & 3 (rs): K27[32:37], p2, k8, p2, knit to

Rows 2 & 4: P27[32:37], k2, p8, k2, purl to end. Row 5: K27[32:37], p2, C4F, C4B, p2, knit to

### Row 6: As row 2.

Rep last 6 rows until front measures 11[14:20] cm, 41/2[51/2:8] in, ending after a ws row.

## Shape raglan

Cont cable patt as set.

Cast off 4 sts at beg of next 2 rows. 58[68:78] sts. Next row: K3, sl1, k1, psso, k to last 5 sts, k2tog,

k3. 2 sts dec'd.

Next row: P3, p2tog, p to last 5 sts, p2tog tbl, p3. 2 sts dec'd.

## For 2nd and 3rd sizes only

Rep last 2 rows twice more. [56:66] sts.

### For all sizes

Next row: K3, sl1, k1, psso, k to last 5 sts, k2tog, k3. 2 sts dec'd.

Next row: Purl.

Rep last 2 rows 6[5:8] more times. 40[44:48]

# Shape neck

Next row (rs): K3, sl1, k1, psso, k2, transfer last 6 sts to a stitch holder, cast off 22[26:30] sts, knit to last 5 sts, k2tog, k3. 10 sts.

# Shape right neck

Cont on first 10 sts.

Next row (ws): Purl.

**Next row:** Sl1, k1, psso, k3, k2tog, k3. 8 sts. Next row: Purl to last 2 sts, p2tog. 7 sts. Next row: Sl1, k1, psso, k2tog, k3. 5 sts.

Next row: Purl.

Next row: K3tog, k2. 3 sts.

Next row: Purl.

Next row: Sl1, k1, psso, k1. 2 sts. **Next row:** P2tog and fasten off.

## Shape left neck

Return sts on holder to needles. Rejoin yarn to ws of left front.

Next row: Purl.

Next row: K2, sl1, k1, psso, k2tog. 4 sts.

Next row: P2tog, p2. 3 sts. Next row: K1, sl1, k1, psso. 2 sts. Next row: P2tog and fasten off.

#### **SLEEVES**

Using 3.5mm needles cast on 37[41:45] sts. Work 12 rows in rib as for back, dec 1 st at end

of last row. 36[40:44] sts.

Work in st-st, inc 1 st at each end of 3rd[3rd:5th] and every foll 2nd[2nd:4th] row to 42[44:70] sts.

### For 1st and 2nd sizes only

Inc 1 st at each end of every foll 4th row to 56[62] sts.

#### For all sizes

Cont without shaping until sleeve measures 15[17:20]cm, 6[61/2:8]in, ending with a ws row.

#### Shape raglan

Cast off 4 sts at beg of next 2 rows. 48[54:62] sts.

Work 8[12:12] rows dec 1 st at each end as set by back in every row. 32[30:38] sts.

Work 18[16:22] rows dec 1 st at each end of next and every foll alt row. 14[14:16] sts.

Cast off.

### **Neck band**

Join both back and right front raglan seams. With rs facing, using 3.5mm needles, beg at left front raglan, pick up and knit 4 sts evenly down left front neck, 19 [23:27] sts across front neck, 7 sts up right front neck, 14[14:16] sts across top of right sleeve, 27[31:35] sts across back neck, 14[14:16] sts across top of left sleeve. 85[93:105] sts.

Beg with 2nd row of rib as for back, work 4 rows.

Cast off in rib.

#### **Button band**

With rs facing, using 3.5mm needles, beg at top of left sleeve, pick up and knit 23[25:29] sts along edge of neck band and raglan slope. Beg with 2nd row of rib as for back, work 6 rows, dec 1 st at lower edge on next 2 alt rows and foll 2 rows. 19[21:25] sts.

Cast off in rib.

### **Buttonhole band**

With rs facing, using 3.5mm needles, beg at bottom of left front raglan (above cast-off sts), pick up and knit 19[21:25] sts along raglan and edge of neck band.

Beg with 2nd row of rib as for back, work 2 rows, inc 1 st at lower end of band on every row, taking extra sts into rib patt. 21[23:27] sts Next row (buttonhole): Rib 2, \*rib2tog, yfwd, rib 5[6:8];rep from \* once more; rib2tog, yfwd, rib 3.

Work 3 more rows in rib, inc 1 st at lower end of band on next and foll alt row, taking extra sts into rib patt as before. 23[25:29] sts Cast off in rib.

### TO MAKE UP

Weave in ends.

Join side and sleeve seams. Sew together lower ends of front opening.


Sew on buttons.

Block to measurements by pinning out and covering with damp cloths. Leave to dry.
