## SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

## G-st (garter stitch) - knit every row.

st-st (stocking stitch) - Row 1 (RS), knit, Row 2(WS), purl.
W\&T (wrap and turn work) slip the next stitch purlwise: bring yarn to front: place slipped stitch back on left hand needle, turn work.

The yarn amounts stated are based on average requirements and are therefore approximate.
TENSION 14 sts and 20 rows to $10 \mathrm{~cm}, 4 \mathrm{in}$, over stocking stitch on 6 mm needles or the size required to give the correct tension.
TENSION 14 sts and 26 rows to $10 \mathrm{~cm}, 4$ in, over garter stitch on 6 mm needles or the size required to give the correct tension.
It is essential to work to the stated tension to ensure the correct size of garment and you should always knit a tension square.

If there are less sts and rows to 10 cm , 4 in , change to finer needles if there are more sts and rows to $10 \mathrm{~cm}, 4 \mathrm{in}$, change to larger needles.

Instructions are given for the first, smallest size. Larger sizes are given in square brackets. Where only one figure is given: this applies to all sizes. Where the figure 0 appears, no stitches, times, or rows are worked for this size.
After casting off, one stitch will remain on the right hand needle which is not included in the instructions that follow.

## Circle the size you wish to make

Special Note: This pattern has been designed with two necklines. A simple cast on, cast off technique suitable for beginner knitters and an integral neckline shaping for more advanced knitters.

Cast on Cast off Neckline is done by shaping the neck and then picking up and casting off the pickup stitches to create a continuous cast off edge.

Integral Neckline is done using short row shaping technique.

## Back \& Front (both alike)

Using 6 mm needles cast on 78[82: 88: 96: 100] sts.
Next row (rs): Knit.
Rep last row 12 times more.
Next row (ws): Purl.
Next row: Knit.
Next row: Purl.
Cont in st-st: dec 1 st each end of next and every $10^{\text {th }}$ row until 64[68: 74: 82: 86] sts rem.
Cont in st-st until work measures
38[37: 38: $37: 38] \mathrm{cm}: 15[141 / 2: 15:$
$141 / 2: 15$ ] in: ending rs facing for next row.
Cont in G-st until work measures 53[53: 55: 55: 56] cm: 21[21: 2112: 21 $1 / 2$ : 22] in ending with rs facing for next row.

## Shape Neck <br> Cast on Cast off neckline

Next row: K27 [29: 32: 36: 38]: place rem sts on holder.
Work on these 27 [29: 32: 36: 38] sts only. Work 2 rows.
Cast off 3 sts at beg of next and foll 2 alt rows. 18[20: 23: 27: 29] sts.
Work one row.
Dec 1 st at beg of next and foll alt row. 16[18: 21: 25: 27] sts.
Cont to work straight until work measures 57[57: 58: 58: 59] cm: $221 / 2\left[221 / 2: 22^{3} / 4: 22^{3} / 4: 23\right]$ in ending with rs facing for next row.

## Shape Shoulder

Cast off 8[9: 11: 13: 14] sts at beg of next row.
Work 1 row.
Cast off rem 8[9: 10: 12: 13] sts.
Re-join yarn and cast off centre 10 sts: knit to end.
Work right side as left side reversing all shapings.

## Neck Trim

Using a 6 mm circular needle pick up 16sts down left front, 10sts across centre front: 16sts up right front, 16sts
down right back, 10sts across centre back and 16 sts up left back. 84sts. Cast off loosely.

## Left Side

Row 1 (RS): K27 [29: 32: 36: 38] W\&T.
Row 2: K27 [29: 32: 36: 38].
Row 3: K24 [26: 28: 33: 35]: W\&T.
Row 4: K24 [26: 28: 33: 35].
Row 5: K21 [23: 25: 30: 32]: W\&T.
Row 6: K21 [23: 25: 30: 32].
Row 7: K18 [20: 22: 27: 29]: W\&T.
Row 8: K18 [20: 22: 27: 29].
Row 9: Cast off 8[9: 11: 13: 14] (with one st on RH needle rem from cast off) K8 [9: 10: 12: 13] W\&T.
Row 10: K9 [10: 11: 13: 14].
Row 11: Cast off 8[9: 10: 12: 13] sts.
Next row: K1: [k next st by placing RH needle up front of wrap at base of the stitch then through the stitch above, knitting the 2sts together: k2] 4 times, K to end of row.

## Right Side

Row 1 (WS): K27 [29: 32: 36: 38] W\&T.
Row 2: K27 [29: 32: 36: 38].
Row 3: K24 [26: 28: 33: 35]: W\&T.
Row 4: K24 [26: 28: 33: 35].
Row 5: K21 [23: 25: 30: 32]: W\&T.
Row 6: K21 [23: 25: 30: 32].
Row 7: K18 [20: 22: 27: 29]: W\&T.
Row 8: K18 [20: 22: 27: 29].
Row 9: Cast off 8 [9: 11: 13: 14] sts (with one st on RH needle rem from cast off) K8 [9: 10: 12: 13] W\&T.
Row 10: K9 [10: 11: 13: 14].
Row 11: Cast off 8[9: 10: 12: 13] sts.
Place marker to indicate end of shoulder shaping and use this as a guide when sewing up.

Cast off all rem stitches, knitting the W\&T's down the right side as you cast off.

## Sleeves

Using 6 mm needles cast on 28[30: 32 : 34: 36] sts.

Next row: Knit.
Rep last row 9[13: 9: 9: 15] times more. Cont in G-st inc 1 st each end of next and every foll $6^{\text {th }}\left[8^{\text {th }}: 8^{\text {th }}: 8^{\text {th }}: 6^{\text {th }}\right]$ row until there are $56[58: 62: 64: 66]$ sts. Cont straight until work measures 44[44: 45: 45: 46] cm. 171/4[171/4: 173/4: $173 / 4: 18]$ in, ending rs facing for next row. Cast off loosely.

## Make Up

Join shoulders and set in sleeves. Sew side seam and sleeve in one.

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
