## SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

C4f - Slip next 2sts to CN and hold at front of work, knit next 2sts then knit 2sts from CN.

> C4b - Slip next 2sts to CN and hold at back of work, knit next 2sts then knit 2sts from CN.

The yarn amounts stated are based on average requirements and are therefore approximate.

TENSION 18 sts and 24 rows to $10 \mathrm{~cm}, 4$ in, over stocking stitch on 5 mm needles or the size required to give the correct tension.

TENSION 22 sts and 24 rows to $10 \mathrm{~cm}, 4 \mathrm{in}$, over cable patt on 5 mm needles or the size required to give the correct tension.

It is essential to work to the stated tension to ensure the correct size of garment and you should always knit a tension square. If there are less sts and rows to $10 \mathrm{~cm}, 4 \mathrm{in}$, change to finer needles if there are more sts and rows to $10 \mathrm{~cm}, 4 \mathrm{in}$, change to larger needles.

Instructions are given for the first, smallest size. Larger sizes are given in square brackets. Where only one figure is given, this applies to all sizes. Where the figure 0 appears, no stitches, times, or rows are worked for this size.
After casting off, one stitch will remain on the right hand needle which is not included in the instructions that follow.

## Crew Neck Cable Jumper Back

Using 5mm needles cast on 96[108, $116,124,134]$ sts.

## $1^{\text {ST }}$ SIZE

Row 1 (rs): P2, *p1, C4f, p4, C4b, $\mathrm{p} 1, \mathrm{k} 12$, rep from * to last 16 sts, p 1 , C4f, p4, C4b, p3.
Row 2: K2, *k1, p4, k4, p4, k1, p12; rep from * to last 16 sts, k1, p4, k4, p4, k3.
Row 3: P2, *p1, k12, p1, C4f, p4, C4b, rep from * to last 16 sts, p1, k12, p3.
Row 4: As row 2.

## $2^{\text {ND }}$ SIZE

Row 1: *K8, p1, C4f, p4, C4b, p1, k4; rep from * to last 4 sts, k 4 .
Row 2: *P8, k1, p4, k4, p4, k1, p4; rep from * to last 4 sts, p4.
Row 3: *P4, C4b, p1, k12, p1, C4f; rep from * to last 4 sts, p4.
Row 4: *K4, p4, k1, p12, k1, p4; rep from * to last 4 sts, $k 4$.

## $3^{\text {rd }}$ SIZE

Row 1 (rs): *K12, p1, C4f, p4, C4b, p 1 ; rep from * to last 12 sts, k12.
Row 2: *P12, k1, p4, k4, p4, k1; rep from * to last 12 sts, p12.
Row 3: *C4f, p4, C4b, p1, k12, p1; rep from * to last 12 sts, C4f, p4,
C4b.
Row 4: *P4, k4, p4, k1, p12, k1; rep from * to last 12 sts, $\mathrm{p} 4, \mathrm{k} 4, \mathrm{p} 4$.

## $4^{\text {th }}$ SIZE

Row 1 (rs): P3, *p1, k12, p1, C4f, p4, C4b; rep from * to last 17 sts, p1, k12, p4.
Row 2: K3, *k1, p12, k1, p4, k4, p4; rep from * to last 17 sts, k1, p12, k4.
Row 3: P3, *p1, C4f, p4, C4b, p1, k12; rep from * to last 17 sts, p1, C4f, p4, C4b, p4.
Row 4: K3, *k1, p4, k4, p4, k1, p12; rep from * to last 17 sts, k1, p12, k4.

## $5^{\text {th }}$ SIZE

Row 1 (rs): *P4, C4b, p1, k12, p1, C4f; rep from * to last 4 sts, p 4 .
Row 2: *K4, p4, k1, p12, k1, p4; rep
from * to last 4 sts, k4.
Row 3: K8, *p1, C4f, p4, C4b, p1, k12; rep from * to last 22 sts, p1, C4f, p4, C4b, p1, k8.
Row 4: P8, *k1, p4, k4, p4, k1, p12; rep from * to last 22 sts, $\mathrm{k} 1, \mathrm{p} 4, \mathrm{k} 4$, p4, k1, p8.

## All Sizes

These 4 rows form patt, rep until work measures $37[36,37,36,37]$ $\mathrm{cm}, 141 / 2[14,141 / 2,14,141 / 2]$ in ending rs facing for next row.
Place markers for armholes.
Cont in patt until work measures $56[56,58,58,60] \mathrm{cm}, 22\left[22,22^{3} / 4\right.$, $223 / 4,231 / 2]$ in, ending rs facing for next row.

## Shoulder shaping

Cast off $28[33,36,39,43]$ sts at beg of next 2 rows. $40[42,44,46,48]$ sts. Place rem sts on holder.

## Front

Using 5mm needles cast on 96[108, $116,124,134]$ sts.
Work same as back until work measures 14 rows less than Back to start of shoulder shaping ending rs facing for next row.

## Shape Neck

Patt 38[43, 46, 49, 53] sts, place rem sts on holder.
Working on these $38[43,46,49,53]$ sts only.
Patt 2 rows.
Next row (ws): Cast off 2 sts at beg of next and foll alt row. 34[39, 42, 45, 49] sts.
Next row: Patt to last 2 sts, k2tog.
Next row: P2tog, patt to end.
Cont to dec this way at neck edge until 28[33, 36, 39, 43]sts rem.
Work 2 rows.
Cast off rem sts.
Place centre 20[22, 24, 26, 28] sts on holder.
Rejoin yarn to rem sts work as left side reversing all shapings.

## Sleeves

Using 5 mm needles cast on $38[40$, 42, 44, 46] sts.
Knit 4 rows.
Cont in st-st inc 1 st each end of next
and every foll $4^{\text {th }}$ row $10[13,14,15$, 16] times and then every foll $6^{\text {th }}$ row until there are $70[76,80,84,88]$ sts. Cont straight until work measures $45[45,46,46,47] \mathrm{cm}, 173 / 4[173 / 4,18$, $18,18^{1 / 2}$ ] in.
Cast off loosely.

## Finishing

Join right shoulder seam.

## Neck Trim

Using 4.5 mm needles, pick up and knit 14[14, 16, 16, 18] sts down left front, $20[22,24,26,28]$ sts from holder, $14[14,16,16,18]$ sts up right front and $40[42,44,46,48]$ sts from back neck st holder. 88[92, 100, 104. 112] sts.
Knit 6 rows.
Cast off loosely.

## Make up

Join Left Shoulder seam and set in Sleeves between markers.
Sew side seams and underarm seam in one.

## Vee Neck Jumper

## Back

Using 5mm needles cast on 96[108, $116,124,134$ ] sts.
Work as set for back of Crew Neck
Cable Jumper, repeating 4 row
pattern rep until 4 reps have been completed.
Cont In st-st until work measures 37[ $36,37,36,37] \mathrm{cm}, 141 / 2[14,141 / 2,14$, $141 / 2$ ] in ending rs facing for next row. Place markers for armholes.
Cont in st-st until work measures
$56[56,58,58,60] \mathrm{cm}, 22[22,223 / 4$,
$\left.22^{3 / 4}, 23^{1 / 2}\right]$ in, ending rs facing for
next row.

## Shoulder Shaping

Cast off $28[33,36,39,43]$ sts at beg of next 2 rows. $40[42,44,46,48]$ sts. Place rem sts on holder.

## Front

Using 5mm needles cast on 96[108, $116,124,134]$ sts.
Work same as back until work
measures $42[44,46,48,50]$ rows
less than Back to start of shoulder shaping.

## Shape Neck

Work $48[54,58,62,67]$ sts place rem sts on holder.
Working on these $48[54,58,62,67]$ sts only.
Work 2 rows.
Dec 1 st at beg of next and every foll alt row until there are $28[33,36,39$, 43] sts.
Cast off loosely.
Work Right side as left side reversing all shapings.

## Sleeves

Using 5 mm needles cast on $40[42$, 44, 46, 48] sts.
Knit 4 rows.
Cont in st-st inc 1 st each end of next and every foll $4^{\text {th }}$ row $13[14,15,16$, 17] times and then every foll $6^{\text {th }}$ row until there are $76[80,84,88,92]$ sts. Cont straight until work measures $45[45,46,46,47] \mathrm{cm}, 173 / 4[173 / 4,18$, $18,181 / 2]$ in.
Cast off loosely.

## Finishing

Join Right shoulder seam.

## Neck Trim

Using 4.5 mm needles starting at left shoulder and rs facing, pick up and knit 40[40, 42, 42, 44] sts down left front, 1 st from centre, $40[40,42,42$, $44]$ sts up right front and $40[42,44$, 46, 48] sts from back neck stitch holder. 121[123, 129, 131, 137] sts.
Row 1 (ws): Knit.
Row 2: Knit to 2 sts before central st, k2tog, k centre st, k2tog, knit to end.
Row 3: Knit.
Row 4: As row 2.
Rep last 2 rows twice more.
Cast off.

## Make up

Join Left Shoulder seam and set in sleeves between markers.
sew side seams and underarm seam in one.
