**Needles:** A set of four 4mm (UK8 - US6) double-pointed needles

Technique: Fair Isle

Special Notes: Charts are worked top down and in the round

#### **Abbreviations**

k knit

**p** purl

st(s) stitch(es)

sl1 slip one stitch

k2tog knit 2 sts together

**ssk** slip next 2 sts knitwise one at a time then knit together through back of loops

**k2tog tbl** knit 2 sts together through the back of the loop **p2tog** purl 2 sts together

rs right side

#### **Pattern**

Using 4mm needles, cast on 24 sts in your chosen main colour (MC) and join to knit in the round being careful not to twist the sts.

#### Work Rib

**Row 1 (rs):** \*K1, p1, repeat from \* to the end of the round Repeat this round once more.

Now work in st-st (k every round) as follows: Beginning with round 1 at top right of chart (see Special Note), work all 14 rounds of chart, repeating the 12 st pattern repeat twice in each round and bringing in the contrast colours as required.

Continuing just in MC work 2 more rounds.

#### Divide for the heel flap

K6 sts and leave these on a spare needle, then using a new needle now work in rows as follows:

**Row 1 (rs):** \*SI1, k1, repeat from \* another 5 times, turn. (12 sts)

**Row 2:** Sl1 p11, turn.

Repeat these two rows 6 more times.

#### Turn the heel

Row 1 (rs): Sl1, K5, k2tog tbl, k1 and turn.

**Row 2:** Sl1, p1, p2tog, p1, turn. **Row 3:** Sl1, k2, k2tog tbl, k1, turn.

**Row 4:** Sl1, p3, p2tog, p1. **Row 5:** Sl1, k4, k2tog tbl, turn.

Row 6: SI1, p4, p2tog. (6 sts on needle.)

#### Shape gusset

SI1 k5, now pick up 7 sts down the side of the heel and one from the gusset, (which is the corner between the heel and leg), K12 pick up 1 st from other gusset and 7 sts up the other side of the heel. (34 sts)

Arrange your needles so that you have 3 heel sts and 8 sts just picked up on Needle 1, 12 sts on needle 2 and 8 sts just picked up and the remaining 3 sts from the heel on needle 3.

Stranding yarn across last 3 sts, now begin working in rounds as follows:

**Next round:** K to last 2 sts on needle 1, k2tog, k12 from needle 2, ssk then k to the end of needle 3.

Next round: K all sts.

These two rounds form the gusset shaping. Continue until you have 6 sts on needle 1, 12 sts on needle 2 and 6 sts on needle 3.

Work 6 rounds knitting all the sts.

#### Shape the toe


**Next round:** \*K3, k2tog, k2, ssk, k3, repeat from \* once

nore.

**Next round:** Knit all sts.

Repeat last two rounds once more, decreasing the number of K sts before the shaping by one each time, then first round only once, finishing on needle 3. (12 sts.) Using needle 3, k 3 sts from needle 1 so that the toe is now on 2 needles (6 sts on each).

Graft the toe. Sew in all the ends.

double-pointed needles

Technique: Fair Isle

Special Notes: Charts are worked top down and in the round

#### **Abbreviations**

**k** knit

**p** purl

st(s) stitch(es)

sl1 slip one stitch

k2tog knit 2 sts together

**ssk** slip next 2 sts knitwise one at a time then knit together through back of loops

**k2tog tbl** knit 2 sts together through the back of the loop **p2tog** purl 2 sts together

rs right side

#### **Pattern**

Using 4mm needles, cast on 24 sts in your chosen main colour (MC) and join to knit in the round being careful not to twist the sts.

#### Work Rib

**Row 1 (rs):** \*K1, p1, repeat from \* to the end of the round Repeat this round once more.

Now work in st-st (k every round) as follows: Beginning with round 1 at top right of chart (see Special Note), work all 14 rounds of chart, repeating the 12 st pattern repeat twice in each round and bringing in the contrast colours as required.

Continuing just in MC work 2 more rounds.

#### Divide for the heel flap

K6 sts and leave these on a spare needle, then using a new needle now work in rows as follows:

**Row 1 (rs):** \*SI1, k1, repeat from \* another 5 times, turn. (12 sts)

**Row 2:** Sl1 p11, turn.

Repeat these two rows 6 more times.

#### Turn the heel

**Row 1 (rs):** Sl1, K5, k2tog tbl, k1 and turn.





Technique: Fair Isle

Special Notes: Charts are worked top down and in the round

#### **Abbreviations**

**k** knit

**p** purl

st(s) stitch(es)

sl1 slip one stitch

k2tog knit 2 sts together

**ssk** slip next 2 sts knitwise one at a time then knit together through back of loops

**k2tog tbl** knit 2 sts together through the back of the loop **p2tog** purl 2 sts together

**rs** right side

#### **Pattern**

Using 4mm needles, cast on 24 sts in your chosen main colour (MC) and join to knit in the round being careful not to twist the sts.







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# T'was the night before Christmas

#### You will need

Yarn: Highland Heathers DK

One ball each of:

MC Shale CC3 Heather

CC1 Bracken CC4 Thrift

CC2 Loch CC5 Cairn

Needles: A set of four 4mm (UK8 - US6)

double-pointed needles

Technique: Fair Isle

**Special Notes:** Charts are worked top down and in the round

#### **Abbreviations**

**k** knit

**p** purl

st(s) stitch(es)

sl1 slip one stitch

k2tog knit 2 sts together

**ssk** slip next 2 sts knitwise one at a time then knit together through back of loops

**k2tog tbl** knit 2 sts together through the back of the loop **p2tog** purl 2 sts together

rs right side

#### **Pattern**

Using 4mm needles, cast on 72 sts in your chosen main colour (MC) and join to knit in the round being careful not to twist the sts.

#### Work Rib

**Row 1 (rs):** \*K1, p1, repeat from \* to the end of the round Repeat this round 7 more times.

Now work in st-st (k every round) as follows: Work 2 rounds.

Beginning with round 1 at top right of chart (see Special Note), work all 82 rounds of chart, repeating the 36 st pattern repeat twice in each round and bringing in the contrast colours as required.

Continuing just in MC work 4 more rounds.

#### Divide for the heel flap

K18 sts and leave these on a spare needle, then using a new needle now work in rows as follows:

**Row 1 (rs):** \*SI1, k1, repeat from \* another 17 times, turn. (36 sts)

**Row 2:** SI1 p35, turn.

Repeat these two rows 18 more times.

#### Turn the heel

Row 1 (rs): SI1, K18, k2tog tbl, k1 and turn.

Row 2: Sl1, p3, p2tog, p1, turn.

**Row 3:** SI1, knit to 1 st before the last turn, k2tog tbl, k1. **Row 4:** SI1, purl to 1st before the last turn, p2tog, p1. Repeat rows 3 and 4 until all the sts have been worked and there are 20 sts on the needle.

#### Shape gusset

SI1, k19, now pick up 18 sts down the side of the heel and one from the gusset, (which is the corner between the heel and leg), K36 pick up 1 st from other gusset and 18 sts up the other side of the heel. (94 sts)

Arrange your needles so that you have 10 heel sts and 19 sts just picked up on Needle 1, 36 sts on needle 2 and 19 sts just picked up and the remaining 10 sts from the heel on needle 3.

Now begin working in rounds again as folls:

**Next round:** K to last 3 sts on needle 1, k2tog, k1, k36 from needle 2, k1, ssk then k to the end of needle 3. **Next round:** K all sts.

These two rounds form the gusset shaping. Continue until you have 18 sts on needle 1, 36 sts on needle 2 and 18 sts on needle 3.

Work 46 rounds knitting all the sts.


#### Shape the toe

**Next round:** :\*K14, k2tog, k4, ssk, k14, repeat from \* once more.

Next round: Knit all sts

Repeat last two rounds twice more, decreasing the number of K sts before the shaping by one each time, then first round only 3 times, finishing on needle 3. (48 sts) Using needle 3, k 12 sts from needle 1 so that the toe is now on 2 needles (24 sts on each).

Graft the toe. Sew in all the ends.






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
