**1st Row:** \* K2, P2, rep from \* to last 2 sts, K2. **2nd Row:** P2, \* K2, P2, rep from \* to end.

Rep 1st and 2nd rows.

St-St. Stocking Stitch.

1st Row: Knit.
2nd Row: Purl.
Rep 1st and 2nd rows.

**C6B.** Slip next 3 sts onto CN and hold at back of work, K3, then K3 from CN. **C6F.** Slip next 3 sts onto CN and hold at front of work, K3, then K3 from CN. **T5F.** Slip next 3 sts onto CN and hold at front of work, P2, then K3 from CN. **T5B.** Slip next 2 sts onto CN and hold at back of work, K3, then P2 from CN.

The quantities of yarn are based upon average requirement and are therefore approximate.

TENSION 18 sts and 24 rows to 10cm, 4in, over stocking stitch and cable panel of 45 sts measures approximately 16cm, 6¼in, using 5mm needles, or the size required to give the correct tension.

VERY IMPORTANT IT IS ESSENTIAL TO WORK TO THE STATED TENSION TO ENSURE SUCCESS.

If there are less sts and rows to 10cm, 4in, change to finer needles; if there are more sts and rows to 10cm, 4in, change to larger needles.

**NOTES:** Instructions are given for 97cm, 38in, larger sizes are given in square brackets.

Where only one figure is given, this applies to all sizes. Where the figure 0 appears, no sts, rows or times are worked for this size.

Owing to photography and printing restrictions the colour reproduction is matched as closely as possible to the yarn.

#### **FRONT**

Using 4mm needles and thumb method cast on 118 [126:130:134:138: 142] sts and work in 2x2 rib for 8cm, ending with a rs row.

**Next Row:** Purl to end.

dec 1 [3:3:3:3:1] sts evenly across row. 117 [123:127:131:135: 141] sts.

Change to 5mm needles and proceed as follows:1st Foundation Row:
K36 [39:41:43:45:48], P2,

K6, P2, K3, (P4, K6) twice, P4, K6, P2, K36 [39:41:43:45:48].

**2nd Foundation Row:** P36 [39:41:43:45:48], K2, (P6, K4) 3 times, P3, K2, P6, K2, P36 [39:41:43:45:48].

<sup>1</sup> Pair of 5mm (UK6 – USA8) Knitting Needles, 1 Pair of 4mm (UK8 – USA6) Knitting Needles, Cable Needle and Stitch Holder.

Proceed as follows:-**1st Row:** K36 [39:41:43: 45:48], P2, K6, P2, K3, (P4, C6F) twice, P4, K6, P2, K36 [39:41:43:45:48]. **2nd Row:** P36 [39:41:43: 45:48], K2, (P6, K4) 3 times, P3, K2, P6, K2, P36 [39:41:43:45:48]. **3rd Row:** K36 [39:41:43: 45:48], P2, C6B, P2, (T5F, T5B) twice, T5F, P2, C6F, P2, K36 [39:41:43:45:48] 4th Row: P36 [39:41:43: 45:48], K2, P6, K2, P3, (K4, P6) 3 times, K2, P36 [39:41:43:45:48]. **5th Row:** K36 [39:41:43: 45:48], P2, K6, P4, (C6B, P4) twice, K3, P2, K6, P2, K36 [39:41:43:45:48].

**6th Row:** P36 [39:41:43: 45:48], K2, P6, K2, P3, (K4, P6) 3 times, K2, P36 [39:41:43:45:48]. **7th Row:** K36 [39:41:43:

45:48], P2, K6, P2, (T5B, T5F) twice, T5B, P2, K6, P2, K36 [39:41:43:45:48]. **8th Row:** P36 [39:41:43:45:48], K2, (P6, K4) 3 times, P3, K2, P6, K2, P36 [39:41:43:45:48]. 1st to 8th row sets st-st and cable panel. Keeping continuity of st-st and cable panel as set

and cable panel as set (throughout) cont until Front measures 51cm, ending with a ws row.

# Divide For Neck Opening.

Next Row: K36 [39:40:42: 43:46], turn, leave rem 81 [84:87:89:92:95] sts on a stitch holder.

Working on these 36 [39: 40:42:43:46] sts only cont until Front measures 72 [73:74:75:76:77]cm, ending with a ws row. Cast off.

With rs facing, rejoin yarn to rem 81 [84:87:89:92:95] sts and proceed as follows:-

Next Row: Cast off 45 [45:47:47:49:49]sts in patt, knit to end. 36 [39:40:42:43:46] sts. Cont without shaping until Front measures 72 [73:74:75:76:77]cm, ending with a ws row. Cast off.

### **BACK**

Using 4mm needles and thumb method cast on 118 [126:130:134:138: 142] sts and work in 2x2 rib for 8cm, ending with a rs row.

Next Row: P7 [5:7:9:1:2], P2tog, (P4 [4:4:4:5:6], P2tog) 17 [19:19:19:19:17] times, P7 [5:7:9:2:2]. 100 [106:110:114:118: 124] sts.

Change to 5mm needles and working in st-st (throughout) cont until Back measures same as Front to shoulders, ending with a ws row.

Cast off.

# SLEEVES (Both Alike)

Using 4mm needles and thumb method cast on 50

[50:54:54:58:58] sts and work in 2x2 rib for 8cm, ending with a ws row. Change to 5mm needles and working in st-st (throughout) inc 1 st at each end of 5th and every foll 6th [6th:6th:6th:6th: 5th] row to 76 [80:82:86: 90:94] sts. Cont without shaping until Sleeve measures 47 [48: 50:51:52:52]cm, ending with a ws row. Shape Sleeve Top Cast off 11 [11:12:12: 13:13] sts at beg of next 6

# COLLAR

12:16] sts.

rows.

Using 4mm needles and thumb method cast on 180 [192:200:208:216: 224] sts.

10 [14:10:14:12:16] sts.

Cast off rem 10 [14:10:14:

**1st Row:** P1, K2, \* P2, K2, rep from \* to last st, P1.

**2nd Row:** K1, \* P2, K2, rep from \* to last 3 sts, P2, K1.

1st and 2nd rows set rib. Work in rib for 5cm, then change to 5mm needles and cont until collar measures same as cast off sts at front of neck, ending with a ws row. Cast off in rib.

## TO MAKE UP

Join shoulder seams. Fold Sleeves in half

lengthways, then placing folds to shoulder seams sew Sleeves in position. Join side and Sleeve seams. Sew cast off edge of Collar evenly in position all round neck edge. Sew Collar in position at front of neck placing left side of Collar over right side of Collar as illustrated. See ball band for pressing and care instructions.
