1 pair 4 mm (UK 8 - USA 6) knitting needles and 1 pair $31 / 4 \mathrm{~mm}$ (UK 10 - USA 3) knitting needles. Stitch holders.

The yarn amounts stated are based on average requirements and are therefore approximate.
TENSION 22 sts and 28 rows to $10 \mathrm{~cm}, 4 \mathrm{in}$, over stocking stitch on 4 mm needles or the size required to give the correct tension.
It is essential to work to the stated tension to ensure the correct size of garment and you should always knit a tension square.
_If there are fewer sts and rows to $10 \mathrm{~cm}, 4 \mathrm{in}$, change to finer needles if there are more sts and rows to $10 \mathrm{~cm}, 4 \mathrm{in}$, change to larger needles.
Instructions are given for the first, smallest size. Larger sizes are given in square brackets. Where only one figure is given, this applies to all sizes. Where the figure 0 appears, no stitches, times, or rows are worked for this size.
After casting off, one stitch will remain on the right hand needle which is not included in the instructions that follow.

## Circle the size you wish to make

## STRIPED TOP BACK

Using $31 / 4 \mathrm{~mm}$ needles, thumb method and A, cast on 114[126:138:150:162] sts.
Work 25 rows in $2 \times 2$ rib.
26th row (ws). P7[6:5:6:8], p2tog, (p12[14:12:13:11], p2tog) 7[7:9:9:11] times, p7[6:5:7:9]. 106[118:128:140:150] sts. Change to 4 mm needles. Working in st-st and stripe sequence of 10 rows in $A, 10$ rows in $B, 10$ rows in $C, 10$ rows in D , and 10 rows in E (throughout) cont until back measures 33[33:35:37:38] cm, $13[13: 133 / 4: 141 / 2: 15]$ in, ending with a ws row.

## Shape Sleeves

Cast on 4 sts at end of next 2 rows.
114[126:136:148:158] sts. ** Cast on 5 sts at end of next 4[4:4:2:2] rows.
134[146:156:158:168] sts. Cast on 6 sts at end of next 2[2:2:4:4] rows.
146[158:168:182:192] sts.
Cont without shaping until sleeve measures
20[22:24:25:26] cm,
8[83/4:91/2:93/4:101/4] in, from last cast on row, ending with a ws row. ***

## Shape Shoulders

Cast off 53[58:63:69:74] sts at beg of next 2 rows.
40[42:42:44:44] sts.
Cast off rem 40[42:42:44:44] sts.

## FRONT

Work as given for Back to **.

## Shape Sleeves

For 1st size only
Divide for neck
Next row. K46, k2tog (neck decrease), (p2, k2) twice, k1, turn, leaving rem 57 sts on a stitch holder.
Working on these 56 sts only work as follows:
Next row. K1, (p2, k2) twice, purl to end, turn and cast on 5
sts. 61 sts.
Next row. Knit to last 11 sts, k2tog, (p2, k2) twice, k1. 60 sts. Next row. K1, (p2, k2) twice, purl to end, turn and cast on 5 sts. 65 sts.
Next row. Knit to last 11 sts, k2tog, (p2, k2) twice, k1. 64 sts.
Next row. K1, (p2, k2) twice, purl to end, turn and cast on 6 sts. 70 sts.
For 2nd, 3rd, 4th and 5th sizes only
Cast on 5 sts at end of next
[4:4:2:2] rows.
[146:156:158:168] sts.
Cast on 6 sts at end of next [2:2:4:4] rows.
[158:168:182:192] sts.
Work [2:6:6:8] rows more without shaping.
Divide for neck
Next row. K[68:73:80:85], k2tog (neck decrease), (p2, k2) twice, k1, turn, leaving rem
[79:84:91:96] sts on a stitch holder.
Working on these [78:83:90:95] sts only work as follows:
Next row. K1, (p2, k2) twice, purl to end.
For all sizes
Next row. Knit to last 11 sts, k2tog, (p2, k2) twice, k1.
69[77:82:89:94] sts.
Next row. K1, (p2, k2) twice, purl to end.
Last 2 rows set neck shaping and neck border.
Work 19[27:23:25:25] rows dec
1 st at neck edge as before in next and every foll alt row.
59[63:70:76:81] sts.
Work 21[17:25:25:25] rows dec
1 st at neck edge as before in next and every foll 4th row.
53[58:63:69:74] sts.
Cont without shaping until front measures same as Back to shoulder shaping, ending with a ws row.

## Shape Shoulder

Cast off rem 53[58:63:69:74] sts. With rs facing, rejoin yarn to 57[79:84:91:96] sts from holder and work as follows:
For 1st size only

Next row. K1, (k2, p2) twice, s1, k1, psso, (neck decrease), knit to end, turn and cast on 5 sts. 61 sts.
Next row. Purl to last 9 sts, (k2, p2) twice, k1.
Rep last 2 rows once more.
65 sts.
Next row. K1, (k2, p2) twice, s1, k1, psso, knit to end, turn and cast on 6 sts. 70 sts.
Next row. Purl to last 9 sts, (k2, p2) twice, k1.
For 2nd, 3rd, 4th and 5th sizes
only
Next row. K1, (k2, p2) twice s1 Next row. K1, (k2, p2) twice, s1, k1, psso, (neck decrease), knit to end.
[78:83:90:95] sts.
Next row. Purl to last 9 sts, (k2, p2) twice, k1.
For all sizes
Next row. K1, (k2, p2) twice, s1, k1, psso, knit to end.
69[77:82:89:94] sts.
Next row. Purl to last 9 sts, (k2, p2) twice, k1.
Last 2 rows set neck shaping
and neck border.
Work 19[27:23:25:25] rows dec
1 st at neck edge as before in
next and every foll alt row.
59[63:70:76:81] sts.
Work 21[17:25:25:25] rows dec
1 st at neck edge as before in
next and every foll 4th row.
53[58:63:69:74] sts.
Cont without shaping until front measures same as Back to shoulder shaping, ending with a rs row.
Shape Shoulder
Cast off rem 53[58:63:69:74] sts on ws.

## SLEEVE EDGINGS

(Both alike)
With rs facing, using $31 / 4 \mathrm{~mm}$ needles and C , pick up and knit 83[91:101:105:109] sts evenly all round sleeve edge.
Work 17 rows in g-st.
Cast off knit wise (on ws).

## TO MAKE UP

Join shoulder, side and sleeve seams, reversing sewing for
$3 \mathrm{~cm}, 1 \frac{1}{4} \mathrm{in}$, for turn-back of sleeves. Pin out top to the measurements given. Cover with clean, damp tea towels and leave until dry. See ball band for washing and further care instructions.

## PLAIN TOP <br> BACK

Using one colour only, work as given for Back of Striped Top to ***.

## Shape Shoulders

Cast off 53[58:63:69:74] sts at beg of next 2 rows.
40[42:42:44:44] sts.
Leave rem 40[42:42:44:44] sts on a stitch holder for Back Neck.

## FRONT

Using one colour only, work as given for Back of Striped Top to **.

## Shape Sleeves

Cast on 5 sts at end of next 4[4:4:2:2] rows.
134[146:156:158:168] sts.
Cast on 6 sts at end of next 2[2:2:4:4] rows.
146[158:168:182:192] sts.
Cont without shaping until
sleeve measures $9[11: 12: 12: 13]$
cm, $31 / 2\left[41 / 4: 43 / 4: 4^{3} / 4: 5^{1} / 4\right]$ in, from
last cast-on row, ending with a ws row.
Shape Neck
Next row. K61[66:71:77:82],
turn, leaving rem
85[92:97:105:110] sts on a
stitch holder.
Working on these
61[66:71:77:82] sts only proceed as follows:
Next row. Purl.
Work 4 rows dec 1 st at neck edge in every row.
57[62:67:73:78] sts.
Work 7 rows dec 1 st at neck edge in next and every foll alt row. 53[58:63:69:74] sts.
Cont without shaping until front measures same as Back to
shoulder shaping, ending with a ws row.

## Shape Shoulder

Cast off rem 53[58:63:69:74] sts.

With rs facing, working on rem 85[92:97:105:110] sts left on a stitch holder, slip first
24[26:26:28:28] sts onto a stitch holder, rejoin yarn to rem 61[66:71:77:82] sts, knit to end.
Next row. Purl.
Work 4 rows dec 1 st at neck edge in every row.
57[62:67:73:78] sts.
Work 7 rows dec 1 st at neck edge in next and every foll alt row. 53[58:63:69:74] sts.
Cont without shaping until front measures same as Back to shoulder shaping, ending with a rs row.

## Shape Shoulder

Cast off rem 53[58:63:69:74] sts.

## NECKBAND

Join right shoulder seam. With rs facing, using $31 / 4 \mathrm{~mm}$ needles pick up and knit 24[24:26:29:29] sts evenly down left side of neck, knit across 24[26:26:28:28] sts left on a stitch holder at centre front
neck, pick up and knit 24[24:26:29:29] sts evenly up right side of neck and knit across 40[42:42:44:44] sts left on a stitch holder at centre back neck.
112[116:120:130:130] sts.
Work 4 rows in g-st.
Next row (ws). K1, k2tog, k35[37:37:39:39], (k2tog) twice, k22[22:24:27:27], k2tog, k20[22:22:24:24], k2tog, k21[21:23:26:26], k2tog, k1. 106[110:114:124:124] sts. Work 3 rows more in g-st. Next row (ws). K1, k2tog, k33[35:35:37:37], (k2tog) twice, k20[20:22:25:25], k2tog, k19[21:21:23:23], k2tog, k20[20:22:25:25], k2tog, k1. 100[104:108:118:118] sts. Work 3 rows more in g-st. Cast off knit wise (on ws).

## SLEEVE EDGINGS

## (Both alike)

Work as given for Sleeve Edgings of Striped Top.

## TO MAKE UP

Join left shoulder and neckband seams. Join side and sleeve seams, reversing sewing for 3 $\mathrm{cm}, 1 \frac{1}{4} \mathrm{in}$, for turn-back of sleeves. Pin out top to the measurements given. Cover with clean, damp tea towels and leave until dry. See ball band for washing and further care instructions.


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
