The yarn amounts stated are based on average requirements and are therefore approximate.

**TENSION** 22 sts and 28 rows to 10cm, 4in, over stocking st on 4mm needles or the size required to give the correct tension.

20 sts and 32 rows to 10cm, 4in, over openwork pattern, on 4mm needles or the size required to give the correct tension.

It is essential to work to the stated tension to ensure the correct size of garment and you should always knit a tension square.

If there are less sts and rows to 10cm, 4in, change to finer needles if there are more sts and rows to 10cm, 4in, change to larger needles.

Instructions are given for the first, smallest size. Larger sizes are given in square brackets. Where only one figure is given, this applies to all sizes. Where the figure 0 appears, no stitches, times, or rows are worked for this size.

After casting off, one stitch will remain on the right hand needle which is not included in the instructions that follow. Although every effort has been made to ensure that instructions are correct, Stylecraft cannot accept any liabilities.

# Cap Sleeved Jumper BACK

Using 4mm needles, cast on 95[105:115:125:135] sts.

**Row 1 (rs):** P3[2:3:2:3], \*k1, p3; rep from \* to last 4[3:4:3:4] sts, k1, p3[2:3:2:3].

**Row 2:** K3[2:3:2:3], \*p1, k3; rep from \* to last 4[3:4:3:4] sts, p1, k3[2:3:2:3].

Last 2 rows set 1x3 rib.

Cont to work in 1x3 rib until Back measures 8cm, 3¼in, ending rs facing for next row.

Row 1 (rs): Knit. Row 2: Purl.

**Row 3-6:** Rep last 2 rows twice more.

Row 7: Knit.

Row 8: Knit.

Row 9: K1, \*p2tog, yrn; rep from \* to last 2 sts, p1, k1.

Row 10: Knit.

Last 10 rows set openwork patt.\*\* Cont to work in openwork patt until Back measures 62[63:64:64:65]cm, 24½[24¾:25½:4:25½]in, ending rs facing for next row.

### Shoulder shaping

Cont in st-st casting off 11[12:14: 15:17] sts at beg of next 2 rows. 73[81:87:95:101] sts.

Next row (rs): Cast off 11[13:14: 16:17] sts, k13[15:16: 18:19], turn leaving rem 48[52:56: 60:64] sts on a holder. 14[16:17:19:20] sts. Cast off 3 sts at beg of next row, work to end of row.

Cast off rem 11[13:14:16:17] sts. With rs facing, rejoin yarn to rem sts, cast off centre 23[23:25:25:27] sts, work to end of row. 25[29:31: 35:37] sts.

Cast off 11[13:14:16:17] sts at beg of next row. 14[16:17:19:20] sts. Cast off 3 sts at beg of next row, work to end of row.

Cast off rem 11[13:14:16:17] sts.

#### **FRONT**

Work as for Back to \*\*. Cont to work in openwork patt until Front measures 46[46:47:46:47]cm, 18[18:18½:18:18½]in, ending rs facing for next row.

#### **Neck shaping**

Work in patt across 47[52:57:62:67] sts, and slip rem 48[53:58:63:68] sts to a holder.

Turn and work Left Front on these 47[52:57:62:67] sts only. Keeping patt correct, dec 1 st at neck edge of foll 9[7:9:8:10] alt rows, then on 5[7:6:7:6] foll 4<sup>th</sup> rows. 33[38:42:47:51] sts. Cont to work straight in patt until Front matches Back to start of shoulder shaping, ending rs facing for next row.

## Shoulder shaping

Work in st-st as foll:
Cast off 11[12:14:15:17] sts at beg of next row. 22[26:28:32:34] sts.
Work 1 row.
Cast off 11[13:14:16:17] sts at beg of next row. 11[13:14:16:17] sts.
Work 1 row.
Cast off rem sts.

### Right front neck shaping

With rs facing place centre st on a holder, rejoin yarn to rem 47[52:57:62:67] sts and work to end.

Keeping patt correct, dec 1 st at neck edge of 9[7:9:8:10] foll alt rows, then on 5[7:6:7:6] foll 4<sup>th</sup> rows. 33[38:42:47:51] sts.
Cont to work straight in patt until Front matches Back to start of shoulder shaping, ending ws facing for next row.

#### Shoulder shaping

Work in st-st as foll:
Cast off 11[12:14:15:17] sts at beg of next row. 22[26:28:32:34] sts.
Work 1 row.
Cast off 11[13:14:16:17] sts at beg of next row. 11[13:14:16:17] sts.
Work 1 row.
Cast off rem sts.

# FINISHING Neck trim

Join left shoulder seam.

With rs facing and using 4mm needles, pick up and knit 34[36:37: 39:39] sts down left front neck, place marker, k1 from holder, place marker, pick up and knit 34[36:37: 39:39] sts up right front neck to shoulder, pick up and knit 29[29:31: 31:33] sts across back neck. 98[102:106:110:112] sts.

Row 1 (ws): K0[1:0:2:0], p0[1:1:1:1], \*k3, p1; rep from \* to last 2[4:1:3:3] sts, k2[3:1:3:3], p0[1:0:0:0].

Row 2: K0[1:0:0:0], p2[3:1:3:3], (k1, p3) 7[7:8:8:8] times, k1, p1, p2tog, slip marker, k1, slip marker, p2tog, p1, \*k1, p3; rep from \* to last 0[2:1:3:1] sts, k0[1:1:1:1], p0[1:0: 2:0]. 96[100:104:108:110] sts. Last 2 rows set rib and neck decs. Work a further 6 rows as set, decreasing 1 st each side of centre neck markers on rs rows. 90[94: 98:102:104] sts. Cast off loosely in rib.

Armhole trims (work both alike)
Join right shoulder seam and neck
trim.

Place markers 19[21.5:23.5:26: 28]cm, 7½[8½:9½:10½:11]in down from shoulder seam on each side, to mark armholes.

With rs facing and using 4mm needles, pick up and knit 83[93: 103:113:123] sts evenly between markers.

**Row 1 (ws):** K3[2:3:2:3], \*p1, k3; rep from \* to last 4[3:4:3:4] sts, p1, k3[2:3:2:3].

**Row 2:** P3[2:3:2:3], \*k1, p3; rep from \* to last 4[3:4:3:4] sts, k1, p3[2:3:2:3].

Last 2 rows set 1x3 rib.

Cont to work in 1x3 rib until Trims

measure 8cm, 31/4in. Cast off loosely in rib.

Join side and armhole trim seams. Pin out sweater to the measurements given. Cover with clean, damp tea towels and leave to dry. See ball band for washing and further care instructions.

# Bardot Sweater BACK

Work as for Cap Sleeved Jumper to

Cont to work in openwork patt until Back measures 56[57:58:59:60]cm, 22[22½:23:23½ :23½]in, ending rs facing for next row.

Work in 1x3 rib as set on Cap Sleeved Jumper Back for 4cm. Cast off all sts.

#### **FRONT**

Work as Bardot Sweater Back.

#### **SLEEVES**

Using 4mm needles, cast on 79[89: 97:111:119] sts.

**Row 1 (rs):** K3[2:2:3:3], \*p1, k3; rep from \* to last 4[3:3:4:4] sts, p1, k3[2:2:3:3].

**Row 2:** P3[2:2:3:3], \*k1, p3; rep from \* to last 4[3:3:4:4] sts, k1, p3[2:2:3:3].

Last 2 rows set 1x3 rib for turned back cuff.

Cont to work in 1x3 rib as set until cuff measures 10cm, 4in, ending rs facing for next row.

Work in st-st, starting with a k row until sleeve measures 36[37:37:38: 38]cm, 141/4[141/2:141/2:15:15]in. Cast off.

## **FINISHING**

Join Front and Back shoulder seams, leaving 29[29:30:30:31]cm, 11½[11½:11¾:11¾:12¼]in open at centre for neck.

Place markers on Front and Back side edges, 18[20.5:22.5:25:27]cm, 7[8:83/4:93/4:103/4]in down from shoulder seam. Sew sleeves to body between markers, ensuring that the centre of the cast-off sleeve matches the shoulder seam. Join side and sleeve seams. Turn back sleeve cuffs and tack in place at seam.

Pin out sweater to the measurements given. Cover with clean, damp tea towels and leave to dry. See ball band for washing and further care instructions.
