YOU WILL NEED

100g balls	3	3	4	4	5	5
Head over Heels						
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Colours used: Ramble 3125

1 Pair of 3.25mm (UK10 – USA3) Knitting Needles, 1 Pair of 2.75mm (UK12 – USA2) Knitting Needles, 1 2.75mm (UK12 – USA2) 100cm Circular Needle, Stitch Holder.

SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

1x1 Rib.
1st Row: *K1, P1, rep from * to last st, K1.
2nd Row: P1, *K1, P1, rep from * to end.
Rep 1st and 2nd rows.

St-St. Stocking Stitch.
1st Row: Knit.
2nd Row: Purl.
Rep 1st and 2nd rows.

SLIPOVER

FRONT

Using 2.75mm needles and thumb method cast on 175 [181:189:195:203:209]sts and work 25 rows in 1x1 rib.
26th Row: Rib 14 [5:9:12:4:7], rib2tog, (rib 4 [5:5:5:6:6], rib2tog) 24 times, rib 15 [6:10:13:5:8]. 150[156:164:170:178:184]sts.

Change to 3.25mm needles and working in st-st (throughout) cont until Front measures 44cm, ending with a ws row.

Shape Armhole and Divide for Neck.

Next Row: Cast off 8 [8:9:10:10:10]sts, K66 [69:72:74:78:81], turn, leave rem 75 [78:82:85:89:92]sts on a stitch holder.

Working on these 67 [70:73:75:79:82]sts only proceed as follows:-

Next Row: Purl.

Next Row: K3, s1, K1, psso, knit to last 5sts, K2tog, K3.

Next Row: Purl to last 5sts, P2togtbl, P3.

64 [67:70:72:76:79]sts.

Work 8 rows dec 1 st at armhole edge **as before** in every row **AT SAME TIME** dec 1 st at neck edge **as before** in 3rd and foll 4th row.

54 [57:60:62:66:69]sts.

Next Row: K3, s1, K1, psso, knit to end. 53 [56:59:61:65:68]sts.

Next Row: Purl.

Work 18 [20:22:22:26:26] rows dec 1 st at armhole edge **as before** in next and every foll alt row **AT SAME TIME** dec 1 st at neck edge **as before** in next and every foll 4th row. 39 [41:42:44:45:48]sts.

Work 47 [49:51:51:51:55] rows dec 1 st at neck edge only **as before** in 3rd [1st:3rd:3rd:3rd:3rd] and every foll 4th row. 27 [28:29:31:32:34]sts. Cont without shaping until armhole measures 25 [26:27:28:29:30]cm, ending with a ws row. Cast off.

With rs facing rejoin yarn to rem 75 [78:82:85:89:92]sts and knit to end.

Shape Armhole.

Next Row: Cast off 8 [8:9:10:10:10]sts, purl to end.

67 [70:73:75:79:82]sts.

Next Row: K3, s1, K1, psso, knit to last 5sts, K2tog, K3.

The yarn amounts stated are based on average requirements and are therefore approximate.

TENSION 28 sts and 36 rows to 10 cm, 4 in, over stocking stitch on 3.25 mm needles or the size required to give the correct tension.

It is essential to work to the stated tension to ensure the correct size of garment and you should always knit a tension square.

The colour reproduction in this pattern is matched as closely as possible to the yarn but due to photography and printing restrictions some slight variations may occur.

Next Row: P3, P2tog, purl to end. 64 [67:70:72:76:79]sts.

Work 8 rows dec 1 st at neck edge **as before** in 3rd and foll 4th row **AT SAME TIME** dec 1 st at armhole edge **as before** in every row.

54 [57:60:62:66:69]sts.

Next Row: Knit to last 5sts, K2tog, K3. 53 [56:59:61:65:68]sts.

Next Row: Purl.

Work 18 [20:22:22:26:26] rows dec 1 st at neck edge **as before** in next and every foll 4th row **AT SAME TIME** dec 1 st at armhole edge **as before** in next and every foll alt row.

39 [41:42:44:45:48]sts.

Work 47 [49:51:51:51:55] rows dec 1 st at neck edge only **as before** in 3rd [1st:3rd:3rd:3rd:3rd] and every foll 4th row. 27 [28:29:31:32:34]sts. Cont without shaping until armhole measures 25 [26:27:28:29:30]cm, ending with a ws row. Cast off.

BACK

Using 2.75mm needles and thumb method cast on 175 [181:189:195:

203:209]sts and work 25 rows in 1x1 rib. **26th Row:** Rib 14 [5:9:12:4:7], rib2tog, (rib 4 [5:5:5:6:6], rib2tog) 24 times, rib 15 [6:10:13:5:8].

150 [156:164:170:178:184]sts.**

Change to 3.25mm needles and working in st-st (throughout) cont until Back measures same as Left Front to Shape Armholes, ending with a ws row.

Shape Armholes.

Cast off 8 [8:9:10:10:10]sts at beg of next 2 rows.

134 [140:146:150:158:164]sts.

Next Row: K3, s1, K1, pss0, knit to last 5sts, K2tog, K3.

Next Row: P3, P2tog, purl to last 5sts, P2togtbl, P3.

130 [136:142:146:154:160]sts.

Rep last 2 rows 4 times more.

114 [120:126:130:138:144]sts.

Next Row: K3, s1, K1, pss0, knit to last 5sts, K2tog, K3.

Next Row: Purl.

112 [118:124:128:136:142]sts.

Rep last 2 rows 9 [10:11:11:13:13] times more.

94 [98:102:106:110:116]sts.

Cont without shaping until armholes measure 25 [26:27:28:29:30]cm, ending with a ws row.

Cast off.

NECKBAND

Join right shoulder seam. With rs facing, **using 2.75mm needles** pick up and knit 75 [78:81:84:87:90]sts evenly down left side of neck, pick up and knit 1 st at centre of V, pick up and knit 75 [78:81:84:87:90]sts evenly up right side of neck and 40 [42:44:44:46:48]sts across cast off sts at back of neck.

191 [199:207:213:221:229]sts.

Next Row: Knit.

Commencing with 1st row of 1x1 rib proceed as follows:-

Next Row: Rib to 5sts at centre of V, (2sts either side of st picked up for V), K2togtbl, K1, K2tog, rib to end.189 [197:205:211:219:227]sts. Next Row: Rib to centre 5sts, P2tog, P1, P2togtbl, rib to end.

187 [195:203:209:217:225]sts. Work 7 rows more dec 1 st either side of centre V st as before.

173 [181:189:195:203:211]sts. Cast off in rib dec as before.

ARMBANDS (Both Alike)

Join left shoulder and Neckband seams. **Using 2.75mm needles** pick up and knit 165 [171:179:187:193:199]sts evenly all round armhole edge.

Next Row: Knit.

Commencing with 1st row of 1x1 rib work 8 rows.

Cast off in rib.

TO MAKE UP

Join side and armband seams. See ball band for pressing and care Instructions.
