## HATS, SCARF & GLOVES IN HEAD OVER HEELS WALKING IN NATURE

1 Pair 3.25mm (UK10 – USA3) Knitting Needles and 1 Pair of 2.75mm (UK12 – USA2) Knitting Needles.

### ABBREVIATIONS

### SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

**St-St. Stocking Stitch.**  
**1st Row:** Knit.  
**2nd Row:** Purl. Rep1st and 2nd rows.  
**M1. Make one stitch.** Pick up loop between last and next stitch and work into back of this loop

### HAT

Using 2.75mm needles and thumb method cast on 145 [151]sts.

**1st Row:** K2, \*P3, K3, rep from \* to last 5sts, P3, K2.

**2nd Row:** P2, K3, \*P3, K3, rep from \* to last 2sts, P2.

1st and 2nd rows set rib. Working in rib as set (throughout) work 4cm, ending with a ws row.

#### Change to 3.25mm needles

and cont until Hat measures 18 [20]cm, ending with a ws row.

#### Shape Crown.

**1st Row:** K2, \*P2tog, P1, K3, rep from \* to last 5sts, P2tog, P1, K2. 121 [126]sts.

**2nd Row:** K2, K2, \*P3, K2, rep from \* to last 2sts, P2.

**3rd Row:** K2, \*P2, K3, rep from \* to last 4sts, P2, K2.

**4th Row:** As 2nd row.

**5th Row:** K2, \*P2, K2tog, K1, rep from \* to last 4sts, P2, K2.

98 [102]sts.

**6th Row:** \*P2, K2, rep from \* to last 2sts, P2.

**7th Row:** K2, \*P2, K2, rep from \* to end.

**8th Row:** As 6th row.

**9th Row:** K2, \*P2tog, K2, rep from \* to end. 74 [77]sts.

**10th Row:** \*P2, K1, rep from \* to last 2sts, P2.

**11th Row:** K2, \*P1, K2, rep from \* to end.

**12th Row:** As 10th row.

**13th Row:** K2tog, \*P1, K2tog, rep from \* to end. 49 [51]sts.

**14th Row:** \*P1, K1, rep from \* to last st, P1.

**15th Row:** K1, \*P1, K1, rep from \* to end.

**16th Row:** As 14th row.

**17th Row:** (K2tog) 24 [25]

times, K1. 25 [26]sts.

Break off yarn, thread yarn through rem sts draw up and fasten off.

### TO MAKE UP

Join back seam. See ball band for pressing and care instructions.

### SCARF

Using 3.25mm needles and thumb method cast on 75 [81]sts

**1st Row:** K3, \*P3, K3, rep from \* to end.

**2nd Row:** \*P3, K3, rep from \* to last 3sts, P3.

1st and 2nd rows set rib.

Cont in rib until Scarf measures

152 [162]cm, ending with a ws row.

Cast off in rib.

### TO COMPLETE

See ball band for pressing and care instructions.

The quantities of yarn are based upon average requirement and are therefore approximate.

**TENSION** 28sts and 36 rows to 10cm, 4in, over stocking stitch using 3.25mm needles, or the size required to give the correct tension. 40sts and 36 rows over 3x3 rib using 3.25mm needles or the size required to give the correct tension. **VERY IMPORTANT IT IS ESSENTIAL TO WORK TO THE STATED TENSION TO ENSURE SUCCESS.**

If there are less sts and rows to 10cm, 4in, change to finer needles, if there are more sts and rows to 10cm, 4in, change to larger needles.

**Notes:** Instructions are given in ladies sizes. Mans size is given in square brackets.

Where only one figure is given, this applies to all sizes. Where the figure 0 appears, no sts, rows or times are worked for this size.

### GLOVES Left Hand

Using 2.75mm needles and thumb method cast on 55 [61]sts.

**1st Row:** K2, \*P3, K3, rep from \* to last 5sts, P3, K2.

**2nd Row:** P2, K3, \*P3, K3, rep from \* to last 2sts, P2.

1st and 2nd rows set rib.

Work 5cm in rib, ending with a rs row.

**Next Row:** Rib 4 [7], rib2tog, (rib 3, rib2tog) 9 times, rib 4 [7]. 45 [51]sts.

**Change to 3.25mm needles** and working in st-st (throughout) work 14 [16] rows.

#### Shape Thumb.

**1st Row:** K21 [24], m1, K1, m1, K23 [26]. 47 [53]sts.

**2nd and Every Alt Row:** Purl.

**3rd Row:** K21 [24], m1, K3, m1, K23 [26]. 49 [55]sts.

**5th Row:** K21 [24], m1, K5, m1, K23 [26]. 51 [57]sts.

**7th Row:** K21 [24], m1, K7, m1, K23 [26]. 53 [59]sts.

**9th Row:** K21 [24], m1, K9, m1, K23 [26]. 55 [61]sts.

**11th Row:** K21 [24], m1, K11, m1, K23 [26]. 57 [63]sts.

**13th Row:** K21 [24], m1, K13, m1, K23 [26]. 59 [65]sts.

#### For a Man.

**15th Row:** K[24], m1, K15, m1, K[26]. [67]sts.

**17th Row:** K[24], m1, K17, m1, K[26].  
[69]sts.

**For a Lady or Man. Next Row:**

Purl.

**Divide for Thumb.**

**Next Row:** K36 [43], cast on  
1 st, turn.

**Next Row:** P16 [20], cast on  
1 st. 17 [21]sts.

Working on these 17 [21]sts only work 21  
[25] rows.

**Next Row:** (P2tog) 8 [10] times, P1. 9  
[11]sts. Break off yarn, run yarn

through rem sts, draw up and fasten off.

With rs facing, rejoin yarn and pick up and knit  
2sts from base of thumb and knit to end.  
46 [52]sts.

\*\*Commencing with 2nd row of st-st work 17  
[21] rows more. **Divide for Fingers.**

**First Finger.**

**Next Row:** K28 [32], turn.

**Next Row:** P10 [12], cast on  
2sts. 12 [14]sts.

Working on these 12 [14]sts only work 22  
[28]rows.

**Next Row:** (K2tog) 6 [7] times.  
6 [7]sts.

Break off yarn, run yarn through rem sts,  
draw up and fasten off.

**Second Finger.**

With rs facing, rejoin yarn and pick up and knit  
2sts from base of first finger, K6 [7] turn.

**Next Row:** P14 [16]sts, cast on 2sts. 16  
[18]sts.

Working on these 16 [18]sts only work 26  
[32] rows.

**Next Row:** (K2tog) 8 [9] times.  
8 [9]sts.

Break off yarn, run yarn through rem sts,  
draw up and fasten off.

**Third Finger.**

With rs facing, rejoin yarn and pick up and knit

2sts from base of second finger, K6 [7] turn.

**Next Row:** P14 [16]sts, cast

on 2sts. 16 [18]sts.

Working on these 16 [18]sts only work 26  
[30] rows.

**Next Row:** (K2tog) 8 [9] times.  
8 [9]sts.

Break off yarn, run yarn through rem sts,  
draw up and fasten off.

**Fourth Finger.**

With rs facing, rejoin yarn and pick up and knit

2sts from base of third finger, K6, turn.

**Next Row:** P14.

Working on these 14sts work  
20 [24] rows.

**Next Row:** (K2tog) 7 times.  
7sts.

Break off yarn, run yarn through rem sts,  
draw up and fasten off.\*\*

**Right Hand**

**Using 2.75mm needles** and thumb method

cast on 55 [61]sts.

**1st Row:** K2, \*P3, K3, rep from  
\* to last 5sts, P3, K2.

**2nd Row:** P2, K3, \*P3, K3, rep from \* to last  
2sts, P2.

1st and 2nd rows set rib.

Work 5cm in rib, ending with a rs row.

**Next Row:** Rib 4 [7], rib2tog,

(rib 3, rib2tog) 9 times, rib 4 [7]. 45 [51]sts.

**Change to 3.25mm needles** and working in st-  
st (throughout) work 14 [16] rows.

**Shape Thumb.**

**1st Row:** K23 [26], m1, K1, m1, K21 [24]. 47  
[53]sts.

**2nd and Every Alt Row:**

Purl.

**3rd Row:** K23 [26], m1, K3, m1, K21 [24]. 49  
[55]sts.

**5th Row:** K23 [26], m1, K5, m1, K21 [24]. 51  
[57]sts.

**7th Row:** K23 [26], m1, K7, m1, K21 [24]. 53  
[59]sts.

**9th Row:** K23 [26], m1, K9,  
m1, K21 [24]. 55 [61]sts.

**11th Row:** K23 [26], m1, K11, m1, K21 [24]. 57  
[63]sts.

**13th Row:** K23 [26], m1, K13, m1, K21 [24]. 59  
[65]sts.

**For a Man.**

**15th Row:** K[26], m1, K15, m1, K[24].  
[67]sts.

**17th Row:** K[26], m1, K17, m1, K[24].  
[69]sts.

**For a Lady or Man. Next Row:**

Purl.

**Divide for Thumb.**

**Next Row:** K38 [45], cast on  
1st, turn.

**Next Row:** P16 [20], cast on  
1st. 17 [21]sts.

Working on these 17 [21]sts

only work 21 [25] rows. **Next Row:**  
(P2tog) 8 [10] times, P1. 9 [11]sts. Break

off yarn, run yarn

through rem sts, draw up and fasten off.

With rs facing, rejoin yarn and pick up and  
knit 2sts from base of thumb and knit to end.  
46 [52]sts.

Work from \*\* to\*\* as given for  
Left Hand Glove.

**TO MAKE UP**

Join all seams. See ball band for care  
instructions.
