SPECIAL ABBREVIATION

 $\mathbf{M1}$ make one stitch by picking up the horizontal strand in between two stitches and knitting through back of loop

The yarn amounts stated are based on average requirements and are therefore approximate.

TENSION Jacket 14 sts and 32 rows to 10 cm, 4 in, over g-st on 6 mm needles or the size required to give the correct tension. **Jumper** 22 sts and 42 rows to 10 cm, 4 in, over g-st on 4 mm needles or the size required to give the correct tension.

It is essential to work to the stated tension to ensure the correct size of garment and you should always knit a tension square. If there are less sts and rows to 10cm, 4in, change to finer needles if there are more sts and rows to 10cm, 4in, change to larger needles. Instructions are given for the first, smallest size. Larger sizes are given in square brackets. Where only one figure is given, this applies to all sizes. Where the figure 0 appears, no stitches, times, or rows are worked for this size. After casting off, one stitch will remain on the right hand needle which is not included in the instructions that follow. Although every effort has been made to ensure that instructions are correct, Stylecraft cannot accept any liabilities. Stylecraft cannot accept responsibility for the result of using any other yarn. Owing to photography and printing restrictions the colour reproduction is matched as closely as possible to the yarn.

JACKET BACK

Using 6 mm needles and yarn A cast on 68[76:84:90:98] sts.

Working in g-st throughout, cont as follows:

Cont straight until back measures 24[25:26:27:28] cm,

 $9\frac{9}{10}$ [$9\frac{3}{10}$:10 $\frac{3}{10}$:11] in, ending with RS facing for next row.

Break off yarn A.

Using yarn B, cont straight until back measures 62[64:68:71:73] cm, 24½[25½:26¾:28:28¾] in, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape shoulders

Cast off 10[12:14:15:17] sts at beg of next 2 rows, then cast off 10[11:13:14:16] sts at beg of foll 2 rows

Leave rem 28[30:30:32:32] sts on a holder.

LEFT FRONT

Using 6 mm needles and yarn A cast on 34[38:42: 45:49] sts.

Working in g-st throughout, cont as follows:

Cont straight until left front measures 24[25:26:27:28] cm,

 $9\frac{1}{2}[9\frac{3}{4}:10\frac{3}{4}:11]$ in, ending with RS facing for next row.

Break off yarn A.

Using yarn B, cont straight until 14[14:18:18:18] rows fewer have been worked than on back to beg of shoulder shaping, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape front neck

Next row (RS): K29[32:37:39:43] and turn, leaving rem 5[6:5:6:6] sts on a holder (for collar).

Dec 1 st at neck edge of next 6 rows, then on foll 3 alt rows, then on 0[0:1:1:1] foll 4th rows. 20[23:27:29:33] sts.

Work 1 row, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape shoulder

Cast off 10[12:14:15:17] sts at beg of next row.

Work 1 row.

Cast off rem 10[11:13:14:16] sts.

RIGHT FRONT

Work as given for left front to beg of front neck shaping.

Shape front neck

Next row (RS): K5[6:5:6:6] and slip these 5[6:5:6:6] sts onto a holder (for collar), K to end. 29[32:37:39:43] sts. Dec 1 st at neck edge of next 6 rows, then on foll 3 alt rows, then on 0[0:1:1:1] foll 4th rows. 20[23:27:29:33] sts

Work 2 rows, ending with **WS** facing for next row.

Shape shoulder

Cast off 10[12:14:15:17] sts at beg of next row.

Work 1 row.

Cast off rem 10[11:13:14:16] sts.

SLEEVES

Using 6 mm needles and yarn A cast on 40[40:42:44:44] sts.

Working in g-st throughout, cont as follows:

Inc 1 st at each end of 17th[13th:11th:11th:9th] and every foll 16th[12th:10th:10th:10th] row to 44[44:50:54:54] sts.

For 1st, 2nd and 3rd sizes only Inc 1 st at each end of every foll 18th [14th:12th] row to 46[48:52] sts.

For all sizes

Cont straight for 7[5:5:7:9] rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Break off yarn A.

Using yarn B, inc 1 st at each end of 11th[9th:7th:3rd:next] and every foll 18th[14th:12th:10th:10th] row to 54[58:64:60:70] sts.

For 4th size only

Inc 1 st at each end of every foll 12th row to 68 sts.

For all sizes

Cont straight until sleeve measures 43 [43:44:45:45] cm, 17[17:17½:17¾:17¾:17¾:17¾: 100 in, ending with RS facing for next row. Cast off.

COLLAR

Join both shoulder seams. With RS facing and using 6 mm needles and yarn A, slip 5[6:5:6:6] sts from right front holder onto right needle, rejoin yarn and pick up and knit 11[11:13:13:13] sts up right side of front neck, K across 28[30:30:32:32] sts on back holder, then pick up and knit 11[11:13:13:13] sts down left side of front neck, and K across 5[6:5:6:6] sts on left front holder. 60[64: 66: 70: 70] sts.

Work in g-st until collar measures 20 cm, 7¾ in, ending with RS facing for next row.

Cast off.

TO MAKE UP

Fold collar in half to inside and slip stitch into position.

Place markers along side seam edges 20[22:24:25:26] cm,

7¾[8¾:9½:9¾:10¼] in, down from shoulder seams (to denote base of armhole openings).

Sew sleeves in position between markers.

Join side and sleeve seams.

Pin out garment to the measurements given.

Cover with a clean, damp tea towel and leave to dry.

See ball band for washing and further care instructions.

JUMPER BACK

Using 4 mm needles and yarn A cast on 108[120:130:142:152] sts.
Working in g-st throughout, cont as

Cont straight until back measures 20[21:22:23:24] cm, 73/4[81/4:83/4:9:91/2] in, ending with RS facing for next row. Break off yarn A.

Using yarn B, cont straight until back measures 58[60:64:67:69] cm, 22³/₄[23¹/₂:25¹/₄:26¹/₂:27¹/₄] in, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape shoulders

Cast off 15[18:20:22:25] sts at beg of next 2 rows, then cast off 15[17:20:22:24] sts at beg of foll 2 rows.

Leave rem 48[50:50:54:54] sts on a holder.

FRONT

Work as given for back until 30[30:32:34:34] rows fewer have been worked than on back to beg of shoulder shaping, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape front neck

Next row (RS): K46[51:57:62:67] sts and turn, leaving rem 62[69:73:80:85] sts on a holder.

Work each side of neck separately. Dec 1 st at neck edge of next 6 rows, then on foll 9[9:10:11:11] alt rows, then on foll 4th row. 30[35:40:44:49] sts. Work 1 row, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape shoulder

Cast off 15[18:20:22:25] sts at beg of next row.

Work 1 row.

Cast off rem 15[17:20:22:24] sts. With RS facing, slip centre 16[18:16:18:18] sts onto a holder, rejoin yarn to rem 46[51:57:62:67] sts and K to end.

Complete to match first side, reversing shapings.

SLEEVES

Using 4 mm needles and yarn A cast on 52[56:58:60:62] sts.

Working in g-st throughout, cont as follows:

Inc 1 st at each end of 15th[11th:9th:9th:9th] and every foll 14th[10th:8th:8th:8th] row to 58[64:64:70:72] sts.

For 3rd size only

Inc 1 st at each end of every foll 10th row to 68 sts.

For all sizes

Cont straight for 5[7:3:7:7] rows, ending with RS facing for next row. Break off yarn A.

Using yarn B, inc 1 st at each end of 9th[5th:7th:next:next] and every foll 14th[12th:10th:10th:8th] row to 68[84:92:96:94] sts.

For First and 5th sizes only

Inc 1 st at each end of every foll 16th[10th] row to 74[102] sts.

For all sizes

Cont straight until sleeve measures 43[43:44:45:45] cm, 17[17:17½:17¾:17¾] in, ending with RS facing for next row. Cast off.

NECKBAND

Join right shoulder seam. With RS facing and using 4 mm needles and yarn A pick up and knit 23[23:25:26:26] sts down left side of front neck, K across 16[18:16:18:18] sts on front holder, pick up and knit 23[23:25:26:26] sts up right side of front neck, and K across 48[50:50:54:54] sts from back holder. 110[114:116:124:124] sts. Beg with a P row, work 5 rows in st-st, ending with RS facing for next row. Cast off loosely, allowing cast-off edge to roll onto RS.

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TO MAKE UP

Join left shoulder and neckband seam. Place markers along side seam edges 18[20:22:23:24] cm, 7[7¾:8¾:9:9½] in down from shoulder seams (to denote base of armhole openings).

Sew sleeves in position between markers.

Join side and sleeve seams.

Pin out garment to the measurements given.

Cover with a clean, damp tea towel and leave to dry.
