MEASUREMENTS

One size	
Eyelet Hat	To fit an average size woman's head

YOU WILL NEED

Eyelet Hat			
Life Vintage Look DK	100g balls	1	
Colour used	Indigo 3224		

1 pair 31/4 mm (UK 10- USA 3) needles, 1 pair 4 mm (UK 8 - USA 6) needles, 5.5 mm (UK 5 – USA 9) needles for flower.

Brooch fastener if required for flower decoration.

The yarn amounts stated are based on average requirements and are therefore approximate.

TENSION

22 sts and 43 rows to 10 cm, 4 in, over patt on 4 mm needles or the size required to give the correct tension.

It is essential to work to the stated tension to ensure the correct size of garment and you should always knit a tension square.

If there are less sts and rows to 10cm, 4in, change to finer needles if there are more sts and rows to 10cm, 4in, change to larger needles.

EYELET HAT

Using 31/4 mm needles and thumb method, cast on 112sts.

1st row. Knit.

This row is called **g-st** (garter-stitch).

Work 5 rows more in q-st. Change to 4 mm needles.

1st to 6th rows.Knit.

7th row.K1, * k2tog, yfwd, rep from * to last st, k1.

8th row. Knit.

These 8 rows form patt.

Cont in patt until hat measures approximately 14cm, 5½ in, ending with 8th row of patt.

Shape Crown

1st row. K1, * k2tog, k9, rep from * to last st, k1. 102sts.

Work 1 row.

3rd row. K1, * k2tog, k8, rep from * to last st, k1. 92sts.

Work 1 row.

5th row. K1, * k2tog, k7, rep from * to last st, k1. 82sts. Work 3 rows.

9th row. K1, * k2tog, k6, rep from * to last st, k1. 72 sts.

Work 1 row.

11th row. K1, * k2tog, k5, rep from * to last st, k1. 62 sts.

Work 1 row.

13th row. K1, * k2tog, k4, rep from * to last st, k1. 52 sts.

Work 3 rows.

17th row. K1, * k2tog, k3, rep from * to last st, k1. 42 sts.

Work 1 row.

19th row. K1, * k2tog, k2, rep from * to last st, k1. 32 sts.

Work 1 row.

21st row. K1, * k2tog, k1, rep from * to last st, k1. 22 sts.

Work 3 rows.

25th row. K1, * k2tog, rep from * to last st, k1. 12 sts.

Break off yarn and thread through rem 12sts.

TO MAKE UP

Join back seam. Cover with a clean, damp tea towel and leave until dry. See ball band for washing and further care instructions.

FLOWER

Outer section

Using 5.5 mm needles and thumb method, cast on 75 sts, tying a marker thread every 15 sts. Cast off these sts leaving a long tail of yarn for sewing. Sew the first st to all the marked sts in the middle, forming 5 petal loops.

Fasten off.

Inner section

Work as given for Outer Section using 4 mm needles.

Sew inner section on top of outer section securing with a button to the centre if

Sew a brooch fastening to the back or sew directly onto hat.
