The yarn amounts stated are based on average requirements and are therefore approximate.
TENSION - Blanket 18 sts and 9 rows (approx.) to $10 \mathrm{~cm}, 4 \mathrm{in}$, measured over ripple patt using 4 mm hook or the size required to give the correct tension.
Cushion - 12 sts and 8 rows (approx.) to $10 \mathrm{~cm}, 4 \mathrm{in}$, measured over rows of tr using 5 mm hook and two strands of yarn or the size required to give the correct tension.
It is essential to work to the stated tension to ensure the correct size of item and you should always crochet a tension square.
If there are less sts and rows to 10 cm , 4 in , change to finer hook if there are more sts and rows to 10 cm , 4in, change to larger hook.

## Circle the size you wish to make

## BLANKET

Using 4mm hook and MC, make 199ch.
Foundation Row: Using MC, tr2tog working first leg into 3rd ch from hook and second leg into next ch, 1tr into each of next 5ch, 3tr into next ch, 1tr into each of next 5ch, * tr3tog working each leg into each of the next 3ch, 1tr into each of next 5ch, 3tr into next ch, 1 tr into each of next 5 ch ; rep from * to last 2ch, tr2tog working each leg into each of the last 2ch, turn.
Row 2: Using A, 2ch, tr2tog working first leg into tr2tog below and second leg into next tr, 1 tr into each of next 5 tr, 3 tr into next tr, 1tr into each of next 5tr,

*     * tr3tog working each leg into each of the next 3 tr , 1 tr into each of next 5 tr, 3tr into next tr, 1 tr into each of next 5 tr ; rep from * to last 2 sts, tr2tog working first leg into last tr and second leg into top of tr2tog, turn.
Row 2 forms the ripple patt and is repeated throughout.
Work 24 rows in patt, working in stripe patt of 1 row of MC and 1 row of contrast colour, changing contrast colour as follows: B, C, D, E, F, G, H, I, J, K, L and M. Cut yarn at end of each row and work over the yarn ends to neaten them. (Last row will be worked in M).
Work 52 rows in patt, working in stripe patt of 2 rows of MC and 2 rows of contrast colour, changing contrast colour as follows: A, B, C, D, E, F, G, H, I, J, K, L and M. Cut contrast colour yarn at end of 2 row stripe and work over the yarn ends to neaten them.
Strand MC up edge of work between stripes. (Last rows will be worked in M). Work 26 rows in patt, working in stripe patt of 1 row of MC and 1 row of contrast colour, changing contrast colour as follows: A, B, C, D, E, F, G, H, I, J, K, L and M. Cut yarn at end of each row and work over the yarn ends to neaten them. (Last row will be worked in M).
Using MC, patt 1 row.
Cut yarn, pull through last loop and fasten off.


## TO MAKE UP

Sew in all yarn ends neatly. Pin out blanket to the measurements given. Cover with clean, damp tea towels and leave until dry. See ball band for washing and further care instructions.

## CUSHION COVER

## (worked in one piece in rounds)

For each colour, use 2 strands of yarn held together to make a thicker yarn.

Using 2 strands of MC held together and 5 mm hook, make 57ch.
Foundation Round: Using MC, 1tr into 2 nd ch from hook, 1 tr into each of next 54ch to end, then work along other side of foundation ch as follows: 1 tr into each of next 55 ch to end, sl st into top of first tr. 110tr
Round 1: Using 2 strands of A, 3ch (counts as 1 tr), 1 tr into each tr to end, sl st into 3rd of 3ch.
Work 21 rounds of $t r$, by repeating round 1, working in stripe patt of 1 round of MC and 1 round of contrast colour, changing contrast colour as follows: B, C, D, E, F, G, H, I, J and K. (Always using 2 strands of each contrast colour). Cut contrast colour yarn at end of each round and work over the yarn ends to neaten them. Strand MC up inside of cushion between stripes. (Last round will be worked in MC).

## Back opening

Round 23: Using L, 3ch (counts as 1 tr), 1tr into each of next 9tr, make 35 ch , miss 35 tr , 1 tr into each of next 65 tr to end, sl st into 3 rd of 3 ch .
Round 24: Using MC, 3ch (counts as 1tr), 1tr into each of next 9tr, 1tr into each of next 35 ch , 1 tr into each of next 65 tr to end, sl st into 3 rd of 3ch.
Round 25: Using M, 3ch (counts as 1tr), 1tr into each tr to end, sl st into 3rd of 3 ch .
Work another 9 rounds of tr, working in stripe patt of 1 round of MC and 1 round of contrast colour, changing contrast colour as follows: N, O, P and Q. (Last round will be worked in MC). Cut yarn, pull through last loop and fasten off.

## BUTTON BAND

With RS of work facing and using MC, rejoin yarn at beg of opening, 3ch (counts as 1tr), 1tr into each of next 34tr, turn.
Next Row: 3ch (counts as 1tr), 1tr into each of next 34tr.
Cut yarn, pull through last loop and fasten off.

## FLOWERS (make 9)

Each flower is worked in 3 colours, using a different colour for each round. Work 9 flowers in the following colour combinations:

1. D, MC, G
2. Q, MC, F
3. B, MC, D
4. F, MC, C
5. I, MC, B
6. L, MC, A
7. $\mathbf{Q}, \mathrm{MC}, \mathbf{A}$
8. H, MC, Q
9. C, MC, P

Using colour 1, make 4ch, sl st into first ch to form a ring.
Round 1: Using $1^{\text {st }}$ colour, 3ch (counts as 1 tr ), 11 tr into ring, sl st into 3 rd of 3ch. 12tr
Round 2: Using $2^{\text {nd }}$ colour, 2ch (counts as 1 htr ), 1 htr into same place, 2 htr into each of next 11 tr , sl st into 2 nd of 2 ch . 24htr
Cut yarn, pull through last loop and fasten off.
Round 3: Join $3^{\text {rd }}$ colour into any htr, (2ch, 1tr) all into same htr, 1 tr into each of next 2 htr , (1tr, 2ch, sl st) all into next htr, * (2ch, 1tr) all into next htr, 1tr into each of next 2htr, (1tr, 2ch, sl st) all into next htr: rep from * 4 times more. 6 petals
Cut yarn, pull through last loop and fasten off. Sew in all yarn ends.

## TO MAKE UP

Sew in all yarn ends neatly. Pin out cushion cover to the measurements given. Cover with clean, damp tea towels and leave until dry. Sew flowers to front of cushion. Push button band to inside of cushion and sew on 5 evenly spaced buttons. Insert cushion pad. Fasten closed using spaces between trs as buttonholes.
See ball band for washing and further care instructions.

## BUNTING

Working flowers as given for Cushion Cover, make as many flowers as required, always using MC for round 2, and altering colours for rounds 1 and 3.

## TO MAKE UP

Using 2 strands of green yarn and 5 mm hook, make 30ch, work 1dc into centre of petal top of first flower, * make 15 ch , work 1dc into centre of petal top of next flower; rep from * until all flowers are joined, make 30ch. Cut yarn, pull through last loop and fasten off. Sew in yarn ends neatly. Pin out bunting. Cover with clean, damp tea towels and leave until dry. See ball band for washing and further care instructions.

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
