MEASUREMENTS

Approximately 18 cm, 7 in, tall

YOU WILL NEED

- 1 x 100g ball of Sweet Dreams DK Sunshine 7024, and Special DK White 1001 70g, Spice 1711 20g
- Optional: 12 mm safety eyes
- Polyester toy stuffing
- A 3.5 mm (UK 9, US E/4) crochet hook
- You will have yarn left over for another project

Magic Ring Make a loop over two fingers, using the hook pull the yarn through the open loop. Make 1 ch then work 1 dc into open loop, working over yarn tail. Work rest of Rnd as instructed then pull yarn end to close loop.

Stuffing: always use new toy stuffing, the type made specially to be suitable for babies and children.Safety Eyes: these can be a choking hazard so they are not recommended for very small children. Always follow the manufacturer's instructions and secure firmly. If in doubt, embroider the eyes instead.

HEAD AND BODY

Use Sunshine Rnd 1: 6 dc in a magic ring Rnd 2: [1 inc] x 6 (12) Rnd 3: [1 dc, 1 inc] x 6 (18) Rnd 4: [2 dc, 1 inc] x 6 (24) Rnd 5: [3 dc, 1 inc] x 6 (30) Rnd 6: [4 dc, 1 inc] x 6 (36) Rnd 7-12:36 dc (36) Rnd 13: FLO [2 dc, 1 inc] x 12 (48) Rnd 14: [7 dc, 1 inc] x 6 (54) Rnd 15: [8 dc, 1 inc] x 6 (60) Place the 12 mm safety eyes in Rnd 13 with 5 st in between. Rnd 16-23:60 dc (60) Rnd 24: [8 dc, 1 dec] x 6 (54) Rnd 25: [7 dc, 1 dec] x 6 (48) Rnd 26: [4 dc, 1 dec] x 8 (40) Rnd 27:[3 dc, 1 dec] x 8 (32) Stuff the head. Rnd 28: [2 dc, 1 dec] x 8 (24) Rnd 29: [1 dc, 1 dec] x 8 (16) Rnd 30: FLO 16 dc (16) Rnd 31: 16 dc (16) Rnd 32: [3 dc, 1 inc] x 4 (20) Rnd 33: 20 dc (20) Rnd 34: [4 dc, 1 inc] x 4 (24) Rnd 35-36: 24 dc (24) Rnd 37: [3 dc, 1 inc] x 6 (30) Rnd 38: [4 dc, 1 inc] x 6 (36) Rnd 39:[5 dc, 1 inc] x 6 (42) Rnd 40-46: 42 dc (42) Rnd 47: [5 dc, 1 dec] x 6 (36) Rnd 48: [4 dc, 1 dec] x 6 (30) Stuff the body and keep stuffing as you work until the final round. Rnd 49: [3 dc, 1 dec] x 6 (24) Rnd 50: [1 dc, 1 dec] x 8 (16) Rnd 51: [1 dec] x 8 (8) Cut yarn, leaving a long yarn end for sewing up. Pull through last loop and draw up tightly.

Weave in and out of last Rnd. Pull tight to close hole and secure yarn.

BEAK

Use Spice Rnd 1:6 dc in a magic ring Rnd 2:[1 inc] x 6 (12) Rnd 3-4:12 dc (12) Rnd 5:[1 inc] x 12 (24) Rnd 6-7: 24 dc (24)

Cut yarn leaving a long end for sewing up. Pull through last loop and draw up tightly. Stuff the snout firmly. Sew the snout onto the head (refer to the photograph for guidance).

HAIR (3x)

Use Sunshine Rnd 1: 6 dc in a magic ring Rnd 2: [1 dc, 1 inc] x 3 (9) Rnd 3-6: 9 dc (9) Rnd 7: 1 dec, 7 dc (8) Rnd 8: 1 dec, 6 dc (7) Rnd 9: 1 dec, 5 dc (6) Rnd 10: 6 dc (6)

Cut yarn leaving a long end for sewing up. Pull through last loop and draw up tightly. Don't stuff the hair. Sew the hair on top of the head (refer to the photograph for guidance).

SHELL

Use White Rnd 1:8 dc in a magic ring Rnd 2:[1 inc] x 8 (16) Rnd 3:[1 dc, 1 inc] x 8 (24) Rnd 4:[3 dc, 1 inc] x 6 (30) Rnd 5:[4 dc, 1 inc] x 6 (36) Rnd 6:[5 dc, 1 inc] x 6 (42) Rnd 7:[13 dc, 1 inc] x 3 (45) Rnd 8-10:45 dc (45) Rnd 11:[1 dc, 1 htr, 1 tr, 1 htr, 1 dc] x 9 (45) Rnd 12:[1 dc, 1 htr, 1 trinc, 1 htr, 1 dc] x 9 (54) Cut yarn leaving a long end for sewing up. Pull through last loop and draw up tightly. Sew the shell onto the body (refer to the photograph for guidance).

WINGS (2x)

Use Sunshine Rnd 1: 6 dc in a magic ring Rnd 2: [1 inc] x 6 (12) Rnd 3: [1 dc, 1 inc] x 6 (18) Rnd 4-6:18 dc (18) Rnd 7: 1 dec, 16 dc (17) Rnd 8: 1 dec, 15 dc (16) Rnd 9: 1 dec, 14 dc (15) Rnd 10:1 dec, 13 dc (14) Rnd 11: 1 dec, 12 dc (13) Rnd 12: 1 dec, 11 dc (12) Rnd 13: 1 dec, 10 dc (11) Rnd 14: 1 dec, 9 dc (10)

Cut yarn leaving a long end for sewing up. Pull through last loop and draw up tightly. Don't stuff the wings. Sew the wings onto the body (refer to the photograph for guidance). Ī

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FEET (2x)

Use Spice

Rnd 1: chain 9

Rnd 2: 1 dc in the second st after your hook, 6 dc, 3 dc in the last chain, 6 dc on the other side of the chain, 2 dc in the last chain (18)

Rnd 3-6: 18 dc (18) Rnd 7: [1 dec, 7 dc] x 2 (16) Rnd 8:16 dc (16)


Rnd 9: [1 dec, 6 dc] x 2 (14) Rnd 10:14 dc (14)

Rnd 11: [1 dec, 5 dc] x 2 (12)

Rnd 12-14:12 dc (12)

Rnd 15: [1 dec] x 6 (6)

Cut yarn leaving a long end for sewing up. Pull through last loop and draw up tightly. Don't stuff the feet. Sew the feet on the base of the shell (refer to the photograph for guidance).







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
