A pair of 5.5mm (UK5 - US9) knitting needles, a pair of 6mm (UK4 - US10) knitting needles, cable needle, stitch holders, stitch markers.

SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

M1 make a st: pick up the horizontal strand lying between the sts and k into the back of it, twisting it.

C4F slip next 2 sts onto cable needle and hold at front of work, k2 then k2 from cable needle.

C4B slip next 2 sts onto cable needle and hold at back of work, k2 then k2 from cable needle.

C6F slip next 3 sts onto cable needle and hold at front of work, k3 then k3 from cable needle.

C6B slip next 3 sts onto cable needle and hold at back of work, k3 then k3 from cable needle.

The yarn amounts stated are based on average requirements and are therefore approximate.

TENSION

14 sts and 20 rows to 10cm (4in) over reverse stocking stitch on 6mm needles or the size required to give the correct tension. Cable panel of 62 sts measures 28cm (11in) wide and cable panel of 91 sts measures 41cm (16¼in) wide using 6mm needles.

It is essential to work to the stated tension to ensure the correct size of garment and you should always knit a tension square.

If there are less sts and rows to 10cm (4in) change to finer needles if there are more sts and rows to 10cm (4in) change to larger needles.

Instructions are given for the first, smallest size. Larger sizes are given in square brackets. Where only one figure is given, this applies to all sizes.

Where the figure 0 appears, no stitches, times, or rows are worked for this size.

SWEATER

BACK

Using 5.5mm needles, cast on 74[80:86:92:101] sts.

Row 1 (rs): P2, *k1, p2; rep from * to end.

Row 2: K2, *p1, k2; rep from * to end.

These 2 rows form p2, k1 rib.

Cont in rib until work measures 8cm, 3¼in, ending with a ws row, dec 2[2:0:0:1] sts evenly on last row. 72[78:86:92:100] sts.

Change to 6mm needles.

Row 1 (rs): P to end.

Row 2: K to end.

These 2 rows form rev st-st.

Cont in rev st-st until back measures 36[36:38:40:41]cm, 14¼[14¼:15:15¾:16¼]in, ending with a ws row.

Shape armholes

Cast off 5[6:7:8:9] sts at beg of next 2 rows. 62[66:72:76:82] sts.

Cont in rev st-st, dec 1 st at each end of next 6[6:7:8:9] rows. 50[54:58:60:64] sts.

Cont in rev st-st without shaping until armholes measure 19[21:23:24:25]cm, 7½[8¼:9:9½:9¾]in, ending with a ws row.

Shape shoulders and back neck

Next row (rs): Cast off 5[5:6:6:7] sts, k10[11:12:12:13] sts (including last st used for casting off) and turn, leaving rem 35[38:40:42:44] sts on a spare needle.

Next row: K2tog, k to end. 9[10:11:11:12] sts.

Cast off 5[5:6:6:7] sts at beg of next row. 4[5:5:5:5] sts.

K 1 row.

Cast off rem sts.

With rs of work facing, slip next 20[22:22:24:24] sts onto a stitch holder for back neck, rejoin yarn to rem 15[16:18:18:20] sts and p to end.

Next row (ws): Cast off 5[5:6:6:7] sts, k to last 2 sts, sl1-k1-psso. 9[10:11:11:12] sts.

P1 row.

Cast off 5[5:6:6:7] sts at beg of next row. 4[5:5:5:5] sts. P 1 row.

Cast off rem sts.

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FRONT

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Using 5.5mm needles, cast on 74[80:86:92:101] sts.

Work 8cm, 3¼in, in p2, k1 rib as given for Back, ending with a rs row.

Inc row (ws): Rib 18[19:22:25:31], M1, (rib 2, M1) 19[21:21:21:20] times, rib to end. 94[102:108:114:122] sts.

Change to 6mm needles.

Row 1 (rs): P16[20:23:26:30], k4, (p3, k9, p1, k9, p3, k4) twice, p16[20:23:26:30] to end.

Row 2 and every foll ws row:

K16[20:23:26:30], p4, (k3, p9, k1, p9, k3, p4) twice, k to end.

Row 3: P16[20:23:26:30], C4F, (p3, C6F, k3, p1, C6F, k3, p3, C4B) twice, p to end. Row 5: As row 1.

Row 7: P16[20:23:26:30], C4F, (p3, k3, C6B, p1, k3, C6B, p3, C4B) twice, p to end.

Row 8: As row 2.

These 8 rows form cable panel with rev st-st at each side.

Cont in patt as set until front measures same as Back to shape armholes, ending with a ws row.

Shape armhole

Keeping cable panel correct as far as possible, cast off 5[6:7:8:9] sts at beg of next 2 rows. 84[90:94:98:104] sts.

Work 6[6:7:8:9] rows, dec 1 st at each end of every row. 72[78:80:82:86] sts.

Cont in patt without shaping until front is 14[14:16:16] rows less than Back to shape shoulders, ending with a ws row.

Shape front neck

Next row (rs): Patt 28[29:30:30:32] sts and turn, leaving rem 44[49:50:52:54] sts on a spare needle.

Work 9 rows, dec 1 st at neck edge on every row. 19[20:21:21:23] sts.

Work 6[6:8:8:8] rows without shaping, ending with a ws row.

Shape shoulder

Cast off 5[5:6:6] sts at beg of next row. 14[15:15:15:17] sts.

Patt 1 row.

Cast off 8[8:8:8:9] sts at beg of next row. 6[7:7:7:8] sts.

Patt 1 row.

Cast off rem sts.

With rs of work facing, slip next 16[20:20:22:22] sts onto a stitch holder for front neck, rejoin yarn to rem 28[29:30:30:32] sts and patt to end.

Work 9 rows, dec 1 st at neck edge on every row. 19[20:21:21:23] sts.

Work 5[5:7:7] rows without shaping, ending with a rs row.

Shape shoulder

Cast off 5[5:6:6] sts at beg of next row. 14[15:15:15:17] sts.

Patt 1 row.

Cast off 8[8:8:8:9] sts at beg of next row. 6[7:7:7:8] sts.

Patt 1 row.

Cast off rem sts.

SLEEVES

Using 5.5mm needles, cast on 35[35:35:38:38] sts. Work 6cm, 2½in, in p2, k1 rib as given for Back, ending with a ws row. Change to 6mm needles. Row 1 (rs): P to end. Row 2: K to end. These 2 rows form rev st-st. Cont in rev st-st, inc 1 st at each end of 3rd and every foll 8th[6th:6th:6th:6th] row to 51[49:55:58:56] sts.

For 2nd, 3rd, 4th and 5th sizes only Inc 1 st at each end of every foll 4th row to [53:59:62:64] sts.

For all sizes

Cont in rev st-st without shaping until sleeve measures 43[43:44:45:45]cm, 17[17:17¼:17¾:17¾]in, ending with a ws row.



Shape Top

Cast off off 5[6:7:8:9] sts at beg of next 2 rows. 41[41:45:46:46] sts.

For 2nd, 3rd, 4th and 5th sizes only Dec 1 st at each end of next and every foll 4th row to [35:39:38:36] sts. Work 1 row.

For all sizes

Dec 1 st at each end of next and every foll rs row to 15[15:17:18:20] sts. Work 1 row. Cast off.

TO MAKE UP Join right shoulder seam.

Neckband

With rs of work facing and using 5.5mm needles, starting at left shoulder, pick up and k 18[18:21:22:22] sts down left side of front neck, k across 16[20:20:22:22] sts from front neck stitch holder as foll: k1[3:3:4:4], k2tog, (k2, k2tog) 3 times, k1[3:3:4:4], then pick up and k 18[18:21:22:22] sts up right side of front neck, 3 sts down side of back neck, k across

20[22:22:24:24] sts from back neck stitch holder then pick up and k 3 sts up side of back neck. 74[80:86:92:92] sts.

Starting with row 2, work 3cm (1¼in) in p2, k1 rib as given for Back, ending with a ws row.

Cast off in rib.

Join left shoulder seam and neckband. Place a marker in centre of each sleeve top. Sew sleeve into armhole, matching centre marker to shoulder seam. Join side and sleeve seams. Pin out sweater to the measurements given. Cover with clean, damp tea towels and leave to dry. See ball band for washing and further care instructions.

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
