Snood, beret, slouchy hat and mittens in Cabaret DK

MEASUREMENTS

One Size

Lace snood	cm	62 x 25
Width x Length	in	24½ x 9¾

Beret, Slouchy hat and Mittens

To fit an average sized lady's head/hand.

YOU WILL NEED

Lace snood

Stylecraft Cabaret DK 100g balls 1

Colour used Mermaid 7221

Beret

Stylecraft Cabaret DK 100g balls 1

Colour used Butterfly 7222

Slouchy hat

Stylecraft Cabaret DK 100g balls 1

Colour used Dragonfly 7223

Mittens

Stylecraft Cabaret DK 100g balls 1

Colour used Dragonfly 7223

Alternative Yarns Any Stylecraft DK yarn. Amounts may vary.

1 pair 3¼ mm (UK 10 – USA 3) knitting needles and 1 pair 4 mm (UK 8 – USA 6) knitting needles for Beret, Slouchy hat and Mittens. 1 pair 6mm (UK 4 – USA 10) knitting needles for Lace snood.

SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

St-st. Stocking stitch

1st row. Knit.

2nd row. Purl.

Rep 1st and 2nd rows.

1x1 Rib

1st Row: K1,*P1,K1; rep from * to end.

2nd Row: P1,*k1,P1; rep from * to end.

m1p make 1 stitch – pick up horizontal strand between last stitch and next stitch to be worked and purl into back of it.

m1 make 1 stitch – pick up horizontal strand between last stitch and next stitch to be worked and knit into back of it.

2x2 Rib

1st Row: * K2, p2, rep from * to last 2 sts, k2.

2nd Row: P2, * k2, p2, rep from * to end.

Rep 1st and 2nd rows.

The yarn amounts stated are based on average requirements and are therefore approximate.

TENSION See tension at the beginning of each pattern.

It is essential to work to the stated tension to ensure the correct size of garment and you should always knit a tension square.

If there are less sts and rows to 10 cm, 4 in, change to finer needles if there are more sts and rows to 10 cm, 4 in, change to larger needles.

After casting off, one stitch will remain on the right hand needle which is not included in the instructions that follow. Although every effort has been made to ensure that instructions are correct, Stylecraft cannot accept any liabilities.

Stylecraft cannot accept responsibility for the result of using any other yarn.

LACE SNOOD

TENSION 13 sts and 20 rows to 10 cm, 4 in over pattern on 6 mm needles or the size required to give the correct tension.

Using 6 mm needles and thumb method cast on 81 sts **loosely**. Work as follows:

1st row. P1, * yrn, p2tog, rep from * to end.

1st row forms **patt**.

Cont in patt until snood measures 25 cm, 9¾ in, ending with a ws row.

Cast off **loosely** purlways.

TO COMPLETE

Join seam. Cover with clean damp, tea towels and leave until dry. See ball band for washing and further care instructions.

BERET

TENSION 22 sts and 30 rows to 10 cm, 4 in over stocking stitch on 4 mm needles or the size required to give the correct tension.

Using 3¼ mm needles and thumb method cast on 133 sts. Work 7 rows in 1x1 rib.

8th row (ws). P11, (p2tog, p2) 28 times, p10. 105 sts.

Change to 4 mm needles and working in st-st work as follows:

1st row. K7, m1, (k10, m1) 9 times, k8. 115 sts.

Work 5 rows.

7th row. K8, m1, (k11, m1) 9 times, k8. 125 sts.

Work 3 rows.

11th row. K9, m1, (k12, m1) 9 times, k8. 135 sts.

12th row. Purl.

Cont without shaping until beret measures 14 cm, 5½ in, ending with a **rs** row.

Next Row. Purl to end inc 2 sts evenly across row. 137 sts.

Shape Crown

1st row. K1, (k2tog, k6) 17 times. 120 sts.

Work 5 rows.

7th row. K1, (k2tog, k5)
17 times. 103 sts.

Work 5 rows.

13th row. K1, (k2tog, k4)
17 times. 86 sts.

Work 3 rows.

17th row. K1, (k2tog, k3)
17 times. 69 sts.

Work 3 rows.

21st row. K1, (k2tog, k2)
17 times. 52 sts.

Work 3 rows.

25th row. K1, (k2tog, k1)
17 times. 35 sts.

26th row. Purl.

27th row. K1, (k2tog) 17 times.
18 sts.

28th row. (P2tog) 9 times.
9 sts.

Break off yarn, run yarn through
rem 9 sts, draw up and fasten
off.

LOOP

Using 3¼ mm needles and
thumb method cast on 14 sts.
Cast off knitways.

TO MAKE UP

Join back seam. Fold loop in
half and sew to centre of crown.
Cover with a damp cloth and
leave until dry. See ball band
for washing and further care
instructions.

SLOUCHY HAT

TENSION 22 sts and 30 rows to
10 cm, 4 in over stocking stitch
on 4 mm needles or the size
required to give the correct
tension.

Using 3¼ mm needles and
thumb method cast on 134 sts.
Work 15 rows in 2x2 rib.

6th row (ws). P6, p2tog, (p4,
p2tog) 20 times, p6. 113 sts.
Change to 4 mm needles and
work in st-st until hat measures
18 cm, 7 in, ending with a ws
row.

Shape Crown

1st row. K1, (k2tog, k6)
14 times. 99 sts.

Work 3 rows.

5th row. K1, (k2tog, k5)
14 times. 85 sts.

Work 3 rows.

9th row. K1, (k2tog, k4)
14 times. 71 sts.

10th and every foll alt row.
Purl.

11th row. K1, (k2tog, k3)
14 times. 57 sts.

13th row. K1, (k2tog, k2)
14 times. 43 sts.

15th row. K1, (k2tog, k1)
14 times. 29 sts.

17th row. K1, (k2tog) 14 times.
15 sts.

18th row. (P2tog) 7 times, p1.
8 sts.

Break off yarn and thread
through rem 8 sts. Pull up tight
and fasten off securely.

TO MAKE UP

Join back seam. Using 12 cm,
4¾ in, diameter cardboard rings
make a pompon and attach to
centre of crown if required.
Cover with a clean, damp tea
towel and leave to dry. See ball
band for washing and further
care instructions.

FINGERLESS MITTENS

(Both alike)

TENSION 22 sts and 30 rows to
10 cm, 4 in over stocking stitch
on 4 mm needles or the size
required to give the correct
tension.

Using 3¼ mm needles and
thumb method cast on 54 sts,
work 5 rows in 2x2 rib.

6th row (ws). P6, p2tog, (p3,
p2tog) 8 times, p6. 45 sts.

Change to 4 mm needles and
work in st-st until mitten
measures 28 cm, 11 in, ending
with a **rs** row.

Next row. P2, m1p, (p5, m1p) 8
times, p3. 54 sts.

Change to 3¼ mm needles and
beg with 1st row of 2x2 rib work
5 rows.

Cast off in rib (on **ws**).

TO MAKE UP

Join seam leaving 4 cm, 1½ in,
opening for thumb, 6 cm, 2½ in,
up from cast on edge. Cover
with a clean damp, tea towel
and leave until dry. See ball
band for washing and further
care instructions.
