## Crochet Hoods in Special Chunky

### MEASUREMENTS

### YOU WILL NEED

<b>2 Colour Hood</b>			
Special Chunky	100g balls	2 balls each	
<b>Colour used</b>	A Black 1002, B Cream 1005		
<b>Hood with Scarf</b>			
Special Chunky	100g balls	2 balls each	
<b>Colour used</b>	A White 1001, B Cloud Blue 1019, C Teal 1062, D Duck Egg 1820		
	1 x 5mm (UK6-USAH/6) hook.		

### ABBREVIATIONS

The yarn amounts stated are based on average requirements and are therefore approximate.

### TENSION

**2 colour hood Motif:** 6 rnds to 16cm, 6¼in, on 5mm hook or the size required to give the correct tension.

**Hood with Scarf:** 7 rnds to 18cm, 7in, on 5mm hook or the size required to give the correct tension

**It is essential to work to the stated tension to ensure the correct size of garment and you should always knit a tension square.**

If there are less sts and rows to 10cm, 4in, change to finer needles if there are more sts and rows to 10cm, 4in, change to larger needles.

## 2 COLOUR HOOD

**Motif** (make 8)

Using A, make 6ch and join with sl st to form a circle.

**Foundation Rnd RS:** 3ch, 2tr, (2ch, 3tr) 3 times, 2ch, join to top of first 3ch with a sl st. Fasten off.

**1st Rnd:** Using B, with RS facing 1 standing tr in any 2ch sp, (2tr, 2ch, 3tr) in same 2ch sp, \*(3tr, 2ch, 3tr) in next 2ch sp, rep from \* 2 more times, sl st to top of first tr. Fasten off.

**2nd Rnd:** Using A, with Rs facing 1 standing tr in any 2ch sp, (2tr, 2ch, 3tr) in same 2ch sp, \* 3tr in sp between next two 3tr groups, (3tr, 2ch, 3tr) in next 2ch sp, rep from \* 2 times more, sl st to top of first tr. Fasten off.

**3rd Rnd:** Using B, with RS facing 1 standing tr in any 2ch sp, (2tr, 2ch, 3tr) in same 2ch sp, \* 3tr in each sp between next two 3tr groups to next corner 2ch sp, (3tr, 2ch, 3tr) in next 2ch sp, rep from \* 2 more times, 3tr in each so between next two 2tr group to last corner, sl st to top of first tr. Fasten off.

Rep 3rd Rnd 3 times changing from colours A to B alternately ending with A.

**MAKING UP** (Use image as a guide)

Using A and whip stitch (or alternatively dc tog), attach 3 motifs together to form one strip (centre motif will sit on top of the head) and attach 4 motifs to form another second strip. Attach the next motif onto the centre motif of the first 3-motif strip, then attach the sides of this centre motif to the side edges of the first and third motif (of the first strip) to begin to form a box.

Attach the second strip to the bottom of the first strip, ensuring that the fourth motif of the second strip fills in the gap (this will be the motif that sits below the chin). Finally attach the edge of the last motif to the edge of the first motif on your second strip. Sew in any remaining ends.

### HOOD WITH SCARF

Work as given for motif of 2 colour Hood in the combination given below.

Make 8 motifs in sequence A, B, C, D, B, A.

Make 8 motifs in sequence C, D, A, B, D, A.

Make 8 motifs in sequence B, C, D, A, C, A.

**MAKING UP** (Use image as a guide)

Note: Arrange motifs in your desired layout before beginning.

Using A and whip stitch (or alternatively dc tog), attach 8 of the motifs in a rectangle of 2 rows wide by 4 rows long.

Fold in half lengthwise and seam one side.

Sew or crochet the remaining motifs to the lower front edge with 8 motifs on each side to form scarf ends, arranging motifs. Fasten off. Sew in all ends.

Make a tassel approx. 12 cm in length using chosen remaining colours.
